

	12	make their own informed decisions concerning their workplace; and
	13	WHEREAS, all farmworkers deserve the same rights as workers in other
	14	industries to vote on whether or not to be represented by a union, to vote on whether or
	15	not to ratify a contract; and
	16	WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Long Beach recognizes and
	17	appreciates the hard work of farm labor that puts food on the Nation's tables.
	18	NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
	19	follows:
	20	Section 1. The Long Beach City Council strongly supports efforts to
	21	provide the farmworkers with the very best working conditions, benefits, the highest
	22	wages, and the options to make their own informed decisions concerning their workplace.
	23	Further, the Long Beach City Council recognizes and appreciates the hard work of the
	24	dedicated farm workers and supports their rights for union representation.
