RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize the Director of the Department of Parks, Recreation and Marine or his or her management designee, to execute a new Fitness Provider Permit and amend Attachment "A" of the Permit as needed.

DISCUSSION

Pursuant to Section 16.16.060 of the Long Beach Municipal Code, Parks and Recreation Commission approval is required of all Fitness Provider Permits for individuals and businesses wishing to use open park space for group exercise classes, personal training and/or boot camps within City Parks (Commercial Recreation/Instruction). As of April 1, 2016, the Department of Parks, Recreation and Marine (PRM) has received one new request for Commercial Recreation/Instruction within City Parks. A summary of the aforementioned requested Fitness Provider Permit to be approved is attached for your consideration and approval.


FISCAL IMPACT:

The recommended action will result in annual revenue of \$350 from the use of Livingston Drive. The revenue will accrue to the General Fund (GP) in the Department of Parks, Recreation and Marine (PR). If the Director approves additional sites annual revenue will increase by a prorated amount per month or \$350 per year, per year.
