- 4. Table Voting Breakdown

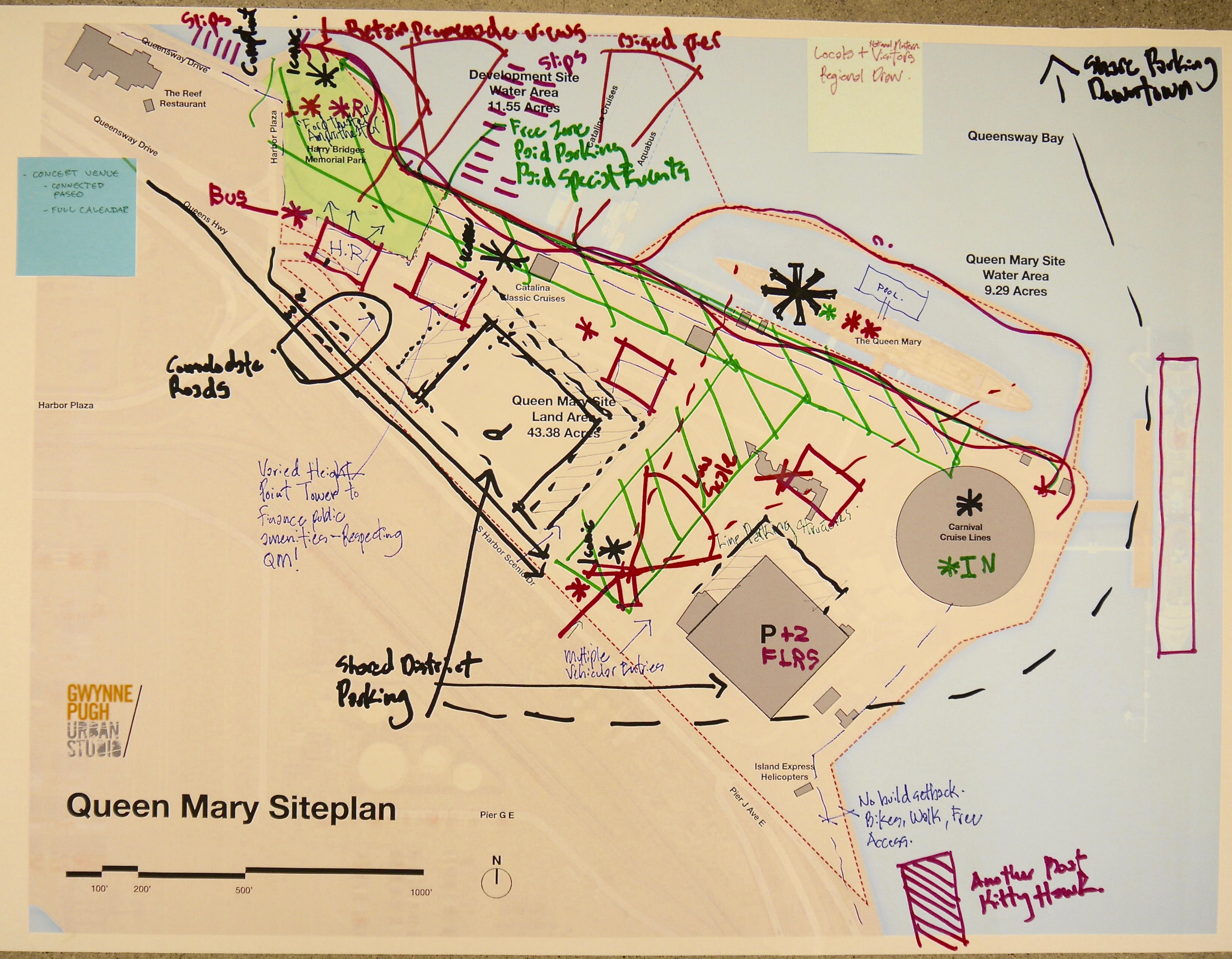

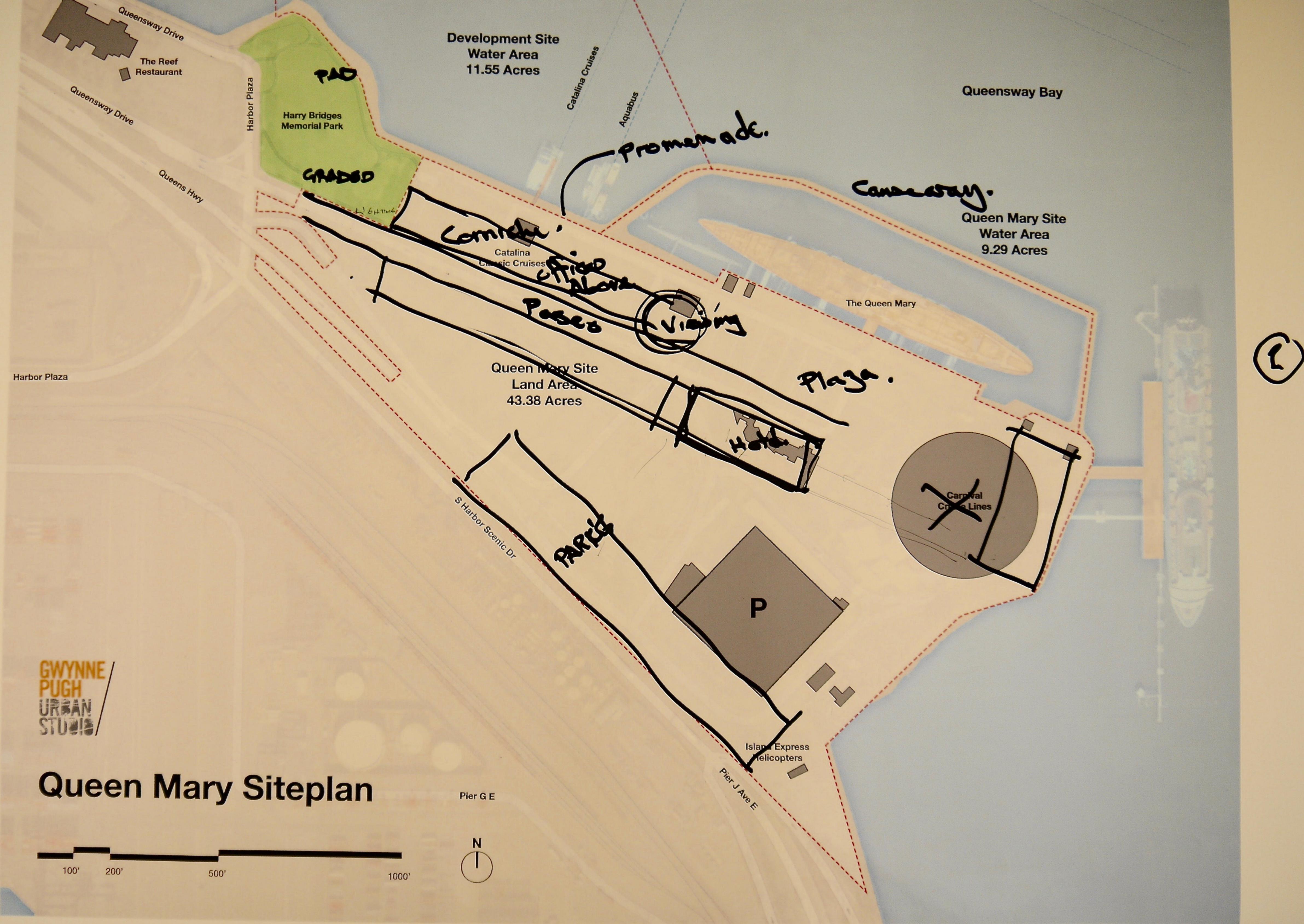
As you consider the alternatives from each of the tables bear in mind the concepts of:

- And any other items for discussion at the upcoming workshop

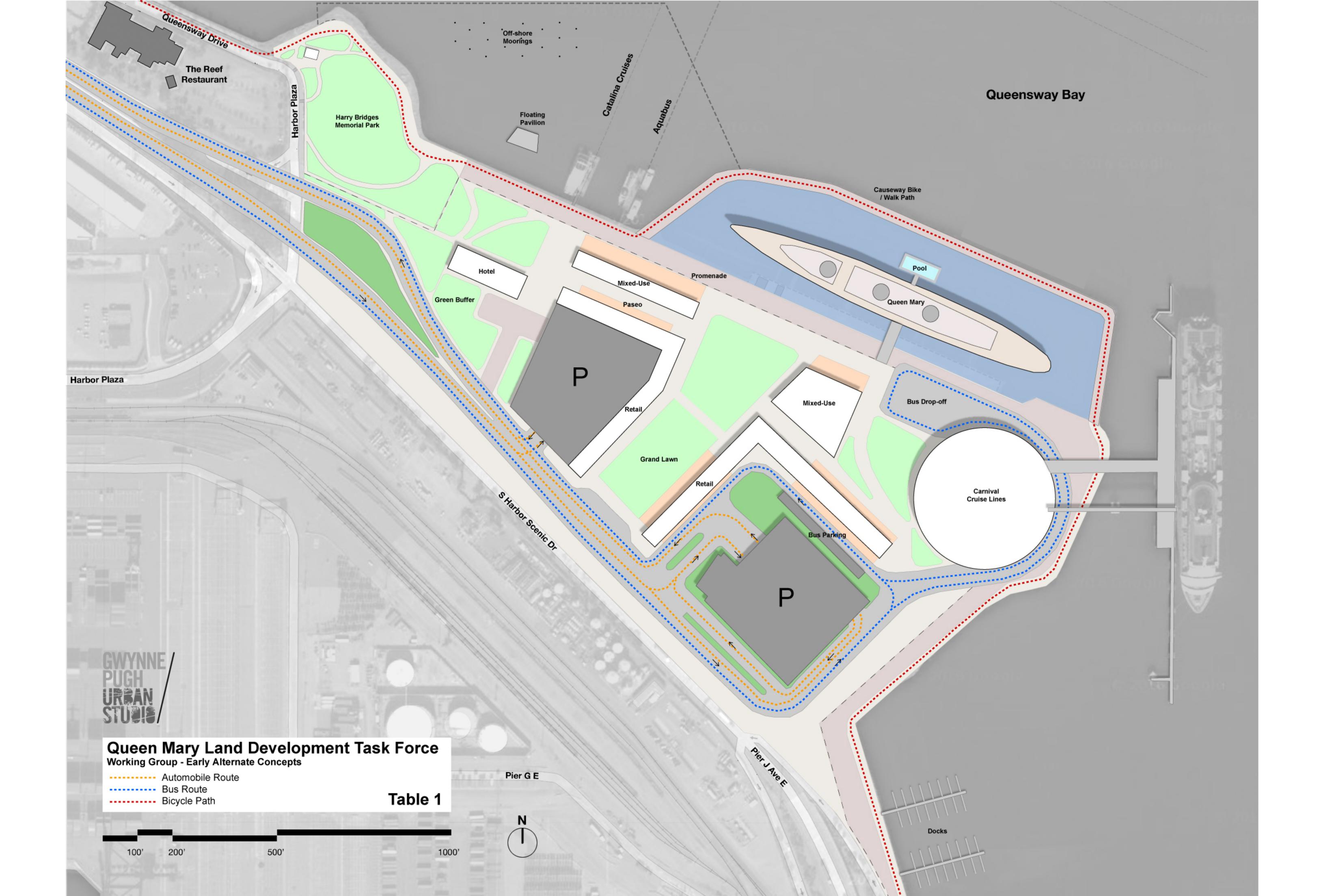
