

- Traffic kept to the perimeter (south) side of the property
- · Bus, cars, taxis use same entrance



PARKING


- · "Aha" moments at arrival
- · Efficient system of entry/exit
- Splitting into multiple points of arrival to control traffic
- 4 structures relate to 4 programmed zones
- Payment integral to entry/exit sequence
- · Approx. 4,600 parking stalls







GRAND MARKET HALL


- Porous ground plan



HOTEL(S)


- · Anchor point along the waterfront

- · Creates activity within the property





Potential mixed-use, retail, commercial rentable space


· Approx. 152,000 sf total



ENTERTAINMENT ZONE


- Re-programmable, accessible fun zones with paid rides



- A visual attraction to compliment the Queen Mary





PUBLIC SPACE


- Varied textures and colors define walking, bicycling, event zones






