

### SUBJECT

Resolution for Fiscal Year 2017 Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Grant

#### RECOMMENDATION

To adopt a resolution authorizing the President and CEO to file an application and execute a grant agreement with the Federal Transit Administration for \$17,506,605 under the Fixing America's Surface Transportation (FAST) Act.

### BACKGROUND

Long Beach Transit (LBT) is eligible to submit capital grants under Section 5307 Urbanized Area Formula Grant Funds of the Fixing America's Surface Transportation (FAST) Act. LBT is able to apply for an estimated \$17,506,605 in federal capital funds.

### ALTERNATIVES CONSIDERED

The Board could decide not to approve the resolution. However, staff does not recommend this option as LBT would be unable to apply for these federal funds and thus implement planned capital projects.

#### **BUDGET/FISCAL IMPACT**

These funds will support LBT's existing capital infrastructure and will be used as follows:

# **RESOLUTION OF** LONG BEACH TRANSIT

Resolution authorizing the filing of applications with the U.S. Department of Transportation, for grants under the Fixing America's Surface Transportation (FAST) Act.

**WHEREAS**, the Secretary of Transportation is authorized to make grants for a mass transportation program of projects and budget;

**WHEREAS**, the contract for financial assistance will impose certain obligations upon the applicant, including the provision by it of the local share of the project costs in the program;

**WHEREAS,** it is required by the U.S. Department of Transportation in accord with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 as amended, the applicant gives an assurance that it will comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the U.S. Department of Transportation requirements thereunder; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the goal of the applicant that disadvantaged business enterprises be utilized to the fullest extent possible in connection with this/these project(s), and that definite procedures shall be established and administered to ensure that disadvantaged businesses shall have the maximum construction contracts, supplies, equipment contracts, or consultant and other services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Long Beach Transit Board of Directors,

- 1. That the President and CEO is authorized to execute and file an application on behalf of Long Beach Transit with the U.S. Department of Transportation to aid in the financing of planning, capital and/or operating assistance projects pursuant to FAST Act.
- 2. That the President and CEO is authorized to execute and file with such applications an assurance or any other document required by the U.S. Department of Transportation effectuating the purpose of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
- 3. That the President and CEO is authorized to furnish such additional information as the U.S. Department of Transportation may require in connection with the application for the program of projects and budget.
- 4. That the President and CEO is authorized to set forth and execute affirmative disadvantaged business enterprise policies in connection with the program of projects and budgets procurement needs.



5. That the President and CEO is authorized to execute grant agreements on behalf of Long Beach Transit with the U.S. Department of Transportation for aid in the financing of the planning, capital and/or operating assistance program of projects and budget.
