AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE

CITY OF LONG BEACH EXTENDING THE TIME LIMIT

FOR EFFECTIVENESS OF THE REDEVELOPMENT PLAN

FOR THE WEST BEACH REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT

(2005-2006)

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Long Beach (the "City Council") adopted Ordinance No. C-4451 on July 21, 1964, approving and adopting the Redevelopment Plan (the "Redevelopment Plan") for the West Beach Redevelopment Project (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, on December 24, 1968, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. C-4785, which amended certain permitted land uses with respect to the Redevelopment Plan; and

WHEREAS, on November 11, 1986, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. C-6309, amending certain limitations with respect to the Redevelopment Plan; and WHEREAS, on December 13, 1994, the City Council adopted Ordinance C-7296, amending certain time limitations with respect to the Redevelopment Plan, and WHEREAS, on November 11, 2003, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. C-7886, eliminating the time limit to incur debt with respect to the Redevelopment Plan; and

WHEREAS, on April 6, 2004, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. C-7914, extending the time limit on the effectiveness of the Redevelopment Plan by one year, or until January 1, 2010; and

WHEREAS, on January 18, 2005, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. C-7964, extending the time limit on the effectiveness of the Redevelopment Plan by one year, or until January 1, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the current time limit on the effectiveness of the Redevelopment Plan established pursuant to the Redevelopment Plan, as amended, is January 1, 2011, and the current time limit on the receipt of tax increment and payment of indebtedness is January 1, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Long Beach,
California, (the "Agency") has been designated as the official redevelopment agency in
the City of Long Beach to carry out the functions and requirements of the Community
Redevelopment Law of the State of California (Health and Safety Code Section 33000
et seq.) and to implement the Redevelopment Plan; and

WHEREAS, Section 33333.6 of the Health and Safety Code was amended by SB 1096 which took effect on September 5, 2004, and which provides that when an agency is required to make a payment pursuant to Section 33681.12 the legislative body may amend the redevelopment plan to extend by one year the time limit on the effectiveness of the plan and the time limit on receipt of tax increment and payment of indebtedness by one year for each year the Agency makes such a payment; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 33681.12 the Agency is required to make a payment to the Los Angeles County Educational Revenue Augmentation Fund for the fiscal year 2005-2006;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach ordains as follows:

Section 1. The time limit on the effectiveness of the Redevelopment Plan, as set forth in Section C.6 of the Redevelopment Plan, as amended by Ordinance Nos. C-4785, C-6309, C-7296, C-7886 and C-7964, shall be amended to read as follows: "The Redevelopment Plan for the West Beach Redevelopment Project is hereby amended to provide that the Redevelopment Plan shall terminate on January 1, 2012."

2	indebtedness pursuant to the Redevelopment Plan, as established in Ordinance	
3	C-7296, as amended, shall be January 1, 2022.	
4	Sec. 3. Ordinance Nos. C-4451, C-4785, C-6309, C-7296, C-7886	
5	and C-7964 are continued in full force and effect except as amended by this Ordinance.	
6	Sec. 4. The City Clerk is hereby directed to send a certified copy of	
7	this Ordinance to the Agency.	
8	Sec. 5. If any part of this Ordinance is held to be invalid for any	
9	reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this	
10	Ordinance, and this City Council hereby declares that it would have passed the	
11	remainder of this Ordinance if such invalid portion thereof had been deleted.	
12	Sec. 6. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance	
13	by the City Council and cause it to be posted in three conspicuous places in the City of	
14	Long Beach, and it shall take effect on the thirty-first day after it is approved by the	
15	Mayor.

WHEREAS, the current time limit on the effectiveness of the Redevelopment Plan established pursuant to the Redevelopment Plan, as amended, is April 3, 2015, and the current time limit on the receipt of tax increment and payment of indebtedness is April 3, 2025; and
