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A RESOLUTION OF THE OVERSIGHT BOARD OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AS THE SUCCESSOR AGENCY TO THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH APPROVING THE DECISION OF THE SUCCESSOR AGENCY TO APPROVE THE DRAFT AMENDED RECOGNIZED OBLIGATION PAYMENT SCHEDULE 16-17B FOR THE PERIOD OF JANUARY 1, 2017 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2017

WHEREAS, Section 34177(o)(1) of the California Health and Safety Code, as adopted by AB1x26 ("Dissolution Act") and most recently amended by Senate Bill 107, requires the Successor Agency to the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Long Beach ("Successor Agency") to prepare an annual Recognized Obligation Payment Schedule ("ROPS") covering the period from July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2017; and

WHEREAS, on September 20, 2016, the Successor Agency to the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Long Beach approved the draft Amended Recognized Obligation Payment Schedule for the period of January 1, 2017 through June 30, 2017;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Oversight Board of the City of Long Beach as the Successor Agency to the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Long Beach ("Oversight Board") resolves as follows:

Section 1. Approve the decision of the Successor Agency to the

Redevelopment Agency of the City of Long Beach to approve the draft Amended Recognized Obligation Payment Schedule for the period of January 1, 2017 through June 30, 2017.

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the Oversight Board, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
