## **RECOMMENDATION:**

Recommendation to declare the attached Ordinances to approve, confirm, and ratify Ordinances No. HD-1978 and HD-1979 of the Board of Harbor Commissioners of the City of Long Beach, which authorize the execution by the Executive Director of the Long Beach Harbor Department of two Grant Deeds between the City of Long Beach and the City of Los Angeles, read for the first time and laid over to the next regular meeting of the City Council for final reading.

## **DISCUSSION**

The Alameda Corridor was primarily constructed on property jointly owned by the Port of Long Beach and the Port of Los Angeles. The southerly end of the Corridor, however, includes property owned by each Port separately. It has been the intent of both Ports that all the Corridor improvements should be located on property jointly owned by both Ports. The following two Deeds represent parcels in the City of Los Angeles that are owned by the City of Long Beach and are improved with tracks that serve the Alameda Corridor. The parcels are located immediately to the south of Anaheim Street and to the east of Henry Ford Avenue. The Deeds transfer 50 percent interest in the City of Long Beach-owned parcels to the City of Los Angeles. At its meeting of December 18, 2006, the Board of Harbor Commissioners approved the Deeds. Under the City Charter, City Council approval is required for any conveyance of property owned by the City. The City of Los Angeles is, likewise, processing conveyances of 50 percent interest in Alameda Corridor-serving Los Angeles-owned parcels to the City of Long Beach.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Charles Gale on February 8, 2007.

## TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

## FISCAL IMPACT

This action has no fiscal impact. Because there are parcels of which Los Angeles is to deed 50 percent interest to Long Beach, the proposed deeds acknowledge that the aggregate value of all the parcels each Port is conveying to the other is equivalent.
