




Phase II Improvements – Marina Vista Park

- Construction of an open water channel between the Lagoon and Marine Stadium
- Construction of two at-grade bridges spanning the open water channel at Colorado Street and Eliot Street
- · Demolish and replace the two existing restrooms in the park
- Reconfigure the baseball and youth overlay soccer fields west of the proposed channel
- Develop a walking trial on the east side of the open channel and install vegetation buffers on both sides of the channel
