On April 9, 2014, detectives with the Vice Investigations Section of the Long Beach Police Department met with you to discuss nuisance related complaints surrounding your establishment. During the meeting, you were advised there had been a significant amount of calls for service attributable to the business consisting of loud music, loud groups, and public intoxication. Detectives suggested the doors, especially the rear door, to the establishment be kept closed while music is played, the volume level of the juke box lowered, and security stationed in the rear parking lot and Maine Avenue as a way to mitigate the complaints.

Detectives reviewed calls for service during the past six weeks, and the same complaints and calls for service exist. The calls for service are consistently occurring on Friday and Saturday evenings between the hours of 9:30 PM and 2:30 AM. The Police Department wants to make you aware of these calls for service, and remind you, as a business owner, it is your responsibility to make an effort to mitigate any nuisance related complaints.
