Narrative**BACKGROUND**

I (Officer J Flores #10007) am a Police Officer in the City of Long Beach assigned to the West Division as a Patrol Resource Officer. I am specifically tasked with impacting Community Oriented Public Safety "COPS" locations.

COPS locations are typically long-term problem locations, which may require other city resources in order to eradicate long-term problems.

Miko's bar, which is located at 710 W. Willow Street, has been identified as a possible problem location by the local residents in the area, specifically several who reside on the 2500 block of Main Avenue. Under the Long Beach Police Department's COPS philosophy, this location is a COPS location. For further see COPS DR #15-62480.

CALL #L152770068

On 10/04/15 at 0051 hours, the call stated there were several subjects standing around vehicles playing loud music. The call went on to state there were subjects standing at the corner being loud and there were several subjects.

DISPATCH:

On 10/21/15, I attended a meeting with the Maine Avenue Neighborhood group at [REDACTED] Avenue, where I contacted Victim Ricky Oropeza. Oropeza understood it was very busy night for patrol and the earliest a patrol unit could be dispatched to this location was 10/05/15 at 0219 hours.

Oropeza went on to tell me the Maine Avenue Neighborhood group purchased a surveillance system and mounted the cameras on his property [REDACTED] Avenue, which is directly south of Miko's bar and across the alley. Due to neighborhood group's concerns regarding the nuisance activity coming from Miko's bar, the surveillance cameras faced the rear door and parking lot of the bar.

SURVEILLANCE VIDEO

Oropeza went on to show me the surveillance video from the night of 10/04/15.

Time stamp 10-04-2015 0056: I observe an unknown female Black subject exit the rear of the bar and walk across the street out of view. In the surveillance video loud music can be heard.

Ricky went on to explain to me the female walked to a dark vehicle across the street. The vehicle was playing the loud music heard in the surveillance video.

Time stamp 10-04-2015 0057: Ricky is heard yelling at the vehicle to turn off the music.

Ricky advised me his peace was disturbed by the vehicle and the music he heard coming from inside the bar when the rear door was opened. Ricky believes the disturbance is caused by Miko's bar and it's patrons. Ricky desired prosecution and signed a Private Person's Arrest Report "PPA"

EVIDENCE:

Due to the lack of knowledge of the DVR system, Oropeza was unable to provide me with a copy of the surveillance video.

On 11/03/15 I returned to [REDACTED] Maine Avenue, where Oropeza was able to provide me a copy of the surveillance video. I uploaded the video to Mideo prior to placing the copy of the video into evidence.
