Narrative

On 01/07/2016, I (Detective S. Johnson #5846), while currently assigned to the Vice Field Team, conducted an ABC compliance check along with Detective Eric Hubbard #5967 at Miko's Sports Lounge, which is located at 710 W. Willow St. in the city of Long Beach.

At approximately 2130 hours, we entered the establishment and a Miko's bar security officer/bouncer, who was posted at the entrance to the business, checked our identification cards. As we walked into the main entrance of the building, we could hear amplified music emitting from inside, but the noise/music was not audible from outside. We sat at a bar table and observed approximately 20 patrons inside the establishment drinking and listening to music. Two of the patrons were walking around with wireless microphones in their hands as they sang karaoke while a disc jockey played the amplified music.

On the north side of the business, approximately 5ft to 10ft from the entrance door was an area designated for a disc jockey. An individual using headphones while utilizing his hands to control the electronic devices to play the amplified music manned the disc-jockey booth, which appeared to include electronic devices. We heard several songs changing from one song to another with consistency expected of a disc jockey.

It is unlawful for the business to provide any entertainment, as they have no valid entertainment permit. It is unlawful for the business to have a DJ and amplified music.

5.72.110(A) LBMC - Permit required and prohibited uses

No person shall carry on, maintain or conduct any entertainment activity in the city without first obtaining a permit therefore from the city.

5.72.115(A) - Definitions.

"Entertainment activity" means any activity conducted for the primary purpose of diverting or entertaining a clientele in a premises open to the general public. Such activity shall include, but shall not be limited to, dancing, whether by performers or patrons of the establishment, live musical performances, instrumental or vocal, when carried on by more than two (2) persons or whenever amplified; musical entertainment provided by a disc jockey or karaoke, or any similar entertainment activity involving amplified, reproduced music.

After observing the entertainment violations for over an hour, we left the establishment.

I, Detective L. Barajas #6221, was notified by Detective Johnson that he went into Miko's Sports Lounge at 710 West Willow Street in an undercover capacity. Detective Johnson told me that while he was inside the establishment he witnessed a disc jockey playing amplified music and people singing karaoke.

On March 17, 2015, Miko's Sports Lounge had a City Council hearing regarding their Entertainment with Dancing Permit application. At that meeting, City Council denied the approval of the application preventing Miko's from applying for a new entertainment permit within a one year period.

Long Beach Special Events and Filming issues the Occasional Event Permits (OEP) in the city. Their office confirmed they did not issue an OEP for this establishment for January 7, 2016.

Using departmental resources, I confirmed the business license for Miko's Sports Lounge is issued to Enaid's Way, Inc. Damitresse "Dede" Yancey is listed as the principal officer.
