AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF LONG BEACH AMENDING THE LONG BEACH
MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SUBSECTION
14.20.200 (C) RELATING TO NEWSRACKS IN BELMONT
SHORE

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that Belmont Shore is a unique part of
Long Beach, containing features which attract visitors from all over Long Beach and
surrounding cities; and

WHEREAS, both residents and visitors contribute to both pedestrian and
vehicular traffic in Belmont Shore; and

WHEREAS, both residents and visitors enjoy using the sidewalks of
Second Street in Belmont Shore; and

WHEREAS, a pilot program initiated in 1997 to regulate the appearance
and location of newsracks has improved the appearance of the sidewalk area as well as
the overall appearance of Second Street; and

WHEREAS, the pilot program improved pedestrian and traffic safety on
Second Street by maintaining clearer sight lines for both pedestrians and drivers;

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach ordains as
follows:

Section 1. Subsection 14.20.200 (C) of the Long Beach Municipal Code
is amended to read in its entirety as follows:

C. This section shall cease to be of any effect on July 1, 2009 unless
extended.

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Section 3. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance by the City Council and cause it to be posted in three (3) conspicuous places in the City of Long Beach, and it shall take effect on the thirty-first (31st) day after it is approved by the Mayor.
