

1 ORDINANCE NO. 2 3 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE 4 CITY OF LONG BEACH EXPANDING THE USES OF THE 5 BELMONT SHORE PARKING METER REVENUE FUND 6 7 WHEREAS, the City Appropriations Ordinance has established the Belmont 8 Shore Parking Meter Revenue Fund, which governs the use of funds collected from 9 parking meters in the Belmont Shore area; and 10 WHEREAS, the City Council now desires to expand the boundaries of this 11 area and the uses for which such funds may be expended; 12 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach ordains as 13 follows: 14 Section 1. The Belmont Shore Parking Meter fund shall be a continuing 15 fund and shall be for the purpose of accounting for revenues from parking meters located within that part of the Belmont Shore area of the City depicted on the map attached 16 17 hereto as Attachment "A". Any expenditures from the Belmont Shore Parking Revenue 18 Fund are hereby expressly limited to and shall be only authorized for the purposes of 19 acquisition, construction, improvement, operation or maintenance (including all services and supplies) of City parking lots, parking facilities, or parking related equipment or 20 21 fixtures; for traffic signals, street lighting, street furniture, landscaping, project art and other appurtenant work and improvements to streets, curbs, gutters and sidewalks on 22 23 public streets and alleys located within or which are for the benefit of the area described 24 in Attachment "A"; or the Bay Shore branch of the Long Beach Public Library. 25 Ordinances No. C-6219 and C-7090 is hereby repealed. Section 2. 26 Section 3. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance by 27 the City Council and cause it to be posted in three (3) conspicuous places in the City of 28 Long Beach, and it shall take effect on the thirty-first (31st) day after it is approved by the
