- Contacted the City of Long Beach, and the Traffic Engineer has submitted request to reinstate NO Parking signs along Loynes Drive and paint the curb red before September 29, 2007
- Red curbs and NO Parking signs were put in place at the end of September

Trash

- Increased security to patrol parking lot during the evening to keep patrons from littering, loitering in cars, or loitering in the lot
- Security cleans parking lot when all patrons have left
- Cleaning crew to pick up trash and/or sweep in the morning from any littering that might occur after closing
