RESOLUTION NO. RES-08-0062

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH CONSENTING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE COLLEGE PARK DRIVE BRIDGE AS PART OF THE SYSTEM OF HIGHWAYS OF LOS ANGELES SYSTEM OF HIGHWAYS

WHEREAS, the County of Los Angeles (the "County") has offered to perform seismic safety retrofit work (the "Retrofit work") on the College Park Drive Bridge (the "Bridge"), which, as depicted in Exhibit "A" to this Resolution, lies partly within the jurisdiction of the City of Seal Beach and partly in the jurisdiction of the City of Long Beach; and

WHEREAS, on October 29, 2002, the County adopted a resolution and in accordance with Section 1700 through 1702 of the California Streets and Highways Code declaring the Bridge to be part of the County system of Highways for the purpose of performing the Retrofit Work; and

WHEREAS, in order for the County to perform the Retrofit Work, Seal Beach must temporarily transfer jurisdiction over the Seal Beach portion of the Bridge to the City of Long Beach so that it may convey jurisdiction over the entire Bridge to the County. On April 14, 2008, the City Council of the City of Seal Beach accordingly adopted a resolution consenting to the temporary transfer of jurisdiction;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The City of Long Beach does hereby accept temporary jurisdiction over the Seal Beach portion of the Bridge to the City of Long Beach and consents to inclusion of the Bridge as party of the County System of Highways, as provided in Sections 1700 through 1702 of the California Streets and Highways Code, for

1 the limited purpose of performing the Retrofit Work.

2 Section 2. The City Council hereby approves and authorizes the City
3 Manager to sign the Memorandum of Understanding between the Cities of Seal Beach
4 and Long Beach regarding the transfer of jurisdiction of the Seal Beach portion of the
5 Bridge.

6 Section 3. The City Council has reviewed the County's environmental
7 findings made pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act in connection with the
8 Retrofit Work, and concurs that the Retrofit Work will not have a significant impact on the
9 environment for the reasons set forth therein.

10 Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
11 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
