

RESOLUTION NO. RES-17-0028

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH MCNEILUS FINANCIAL, INC. DBA MCNEILUS TRUCK AND MANUFACTURING COMPANY, WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, FOR THE PURCHASE OF MCNEILUS REFUSE COLLECTION TRUCK BODY PARTS FOR A PERIOD OF TWO YEARS WITH THE OPTION TO RENEW FOR TWO ADDITIONAL ONE-YEAR PERIODS IN AN ANNUAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$250,000

WHEREAS, the Department of Financial Management, Fleet Services Bureau, contains 58 refuse collection trucks ("Trucks) that require McNeilus refuse collection truck body parts; and

WHEREAS, Public Works and other City departments heavily use these Trucks in difficult environments, necessitating frequent replacement of parts to provide the necessary level of service; and

WHEREAS, McNeilus Financial, Inc. is the sole source provider of McNeilus refuse collection truck body parts in the state of California, and is the only original equipment manufacturer (OEM) of McNeilus parts for the United States; and

WHEREAS, as a result, no useful purpose would be served by advertising for bids and to do so would constitute an idle and useless act and an unnecessary expenditure of public funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a

contract, without advertising for bids, with McNeilus Financial, Inc. for the purchase of McNeilus refuse collection truck body parts as may be required by the City for a period of two (2) years in an annual amount not to exceed Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000). The parties may, by mutual agreement, extend the term for two (2) additional periods of one (1) year each.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.


