Patrick H. West, have mutually agreed to memorialize the provisions for compensation in
an amendment to the existing contract;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. That an amendment in the form attached hereto as Exhibit "A", by and between the City of Long Beach and Patrick H. West, which sets forth the terms of compensation for Patrick H. West be approved and executed. This second amendment to the contract shall contain the following terms: The City shall increase the City Manager's current annual compensation of \$259,956.00 by two percent (2%) effective October 1, 2016. Thereafter, the City shall increase the City Manager's compensation by an additional two percent (2%) effective October 1, 2017, and by an additional two percent (2%) effective October 1, 2018.

Section 2. Additionally, a one-time ad hoc payment of three percent (3%) of annual base pay will be provided on a prorated basis for work performed between October 1, 2015 through September 30, 2016.

Section 3. The City Attorney is authorized and directed to cause the preparation of an amendment to the City Manager's contract with the City of Long Beach.

Section 1. The language in Section 5 of Agreement No. 30228, including the First Amendment, is deleted in its entirety and amended to read as follows:

- 5. <u>Compensation</u>. The City shall increase the City Manager's current annual compensation of \$259,956.00 by two percent (2%) effective October 1, 2016. Thereafter, the City shall increase the City Manager's compensation by an additional two percent (2%) effective October 1, 2017 and by an additional two percent (2%) effective October 1, 2018.
- Section 2 Additionally, a one-time ad hoc payment of three (3%) percent of annual base pay will be provided on a prorated basis for work performed between October 1, 2015 through September 30, 2016.
- Section 3. Except as expressly amended in this Second Amendment, all terms and conditions in Agreement 30228 are ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.
