



THE SEA FESTIVAL ASSOCIATION OF LONG BEACH

2008 Report to the City Manager:

1) Original Objectives:

- a) Assemble the individual Sea Festival events into a cohesive package of "branded" Long Beach events, emphasizing the recreational and lifestyle values that Long Beach has to offer to its citizens, as well as visitors.
- Market Long Beach as a summer destination to the greater Southern California market.
- Build a "Pride Factor" within the community around the beach and ocean assets.
- d) Develop and promote programs within the City to encourage Long Beach citizens who live in the West, Central and North Districts of Long Beach to participate in beach and ocean activities.
- e) As a result of operating new high profile events, create new positive economic impacts for Long Beach.
- f) Encourage private sector Long Beach businesses to "get involved" with Sea Festival and Sea Festival events.
- g) By 2011, make Sea Festival a "stand along financial business model."

2) 2008 Results:

One of the major objectives for 2008, was to increase the awareness and attendance of the "Community Events," and to build those events into the "Public/Private Partnership" inventory of Sea Festival events. With the assistance of Supervisor Don Knabe, Charter Communications, and the Department of Parks, Recreation and Marine, more than 6,000 disadvantaged Long Beach youth enjoyed these events for the first time. Examples of such events in 2008 were:

1) Aquarium and Beach Days:

A special "price" was negotiated with the Aquarium of the Pacific whereby four groups, 200 each, of "inner city" youngsters enjoyed a morning visit to the Aquarium of the Pacific, followed by a harbor cruise.

2) Kids Fishing Rodeo:

One of the oldest events on the annual Sea Festival calendar, this event was for the first time integrated into the Parks, Recreation and Marine Department summer program. And, for the first time, the Fred Hall Fishing Show joined the event as Title Sponsor, providing over 250 free rods and reels, caps and T-shirts to the youngsters. The 2008 event, which was managed by the Southern California Tuna Club, attracted an additional 350 youngsters, thus making the attendance for the event at the 600 mark.

3) The Great Sand Sculpture Beach Day:

Thanks to the Port of Long Beach and the Long Beach Junior Chamber of Commerce, the Great Sand Sculpture Championship was expanded to include a Friday event, whereby almost 1,000 youngsters enjoyed a day at the beach building sand sculptures, playing beach games, and participating in a variety of beach activities. The event continued on to Saturday, and enjoyed its highest participation and entry level in years. As with the addition of the Fred Hall Fishing Show to the Kids Fishing Rodeo, the Long Beach Junior Chamber of Commerce took this event to a "new level."

4) Capture The Wind Festival:

As with the Great Sand Sculpture Beach Day, so was the Capture the Wind Festival increased to include a Friday event. With the assistance of the Airport Department, Supervisor Don Knabe, Charter Communications, and the Port of Long Beach, more than 950 youth enjoyed a day at the beach each flying their very own "donated" kite. They also enjoyed beach games and participated in a variety of beach activities.

5) Beach Volleyball:

In concert with the AVP, Charter Communications and the YMCA, over 150 youth from the inner city were introduced to beach volleyball on the Wednesday evening prior to the AVP tournament. This event was a forerunner to a much larger program planned for 2009, and involving "Dig for Kids," a nationally recognized beach volleyball program for underprivileged youth, which will be moving to Long Beach.

6) Tennis and Golf Clinics, Sailing on the American Pride, Novice Swim Meet:

With the assistance from American Golf and First Serve, Inc., almost 200 youngsters from the summer programs were introduced to golf and tennis for the first time. Likewise, over 725 young people enjoyed an outing on the tall ship, American Pride.

At the City pools, over 100 youth enjoyed learning swimming and competing in the Annual Novice Swim Meet.

It should be noted that in 2009, one of the Sea Festival goals will be to bring increased corporate support to these type of events, in order to increase their size and the opportunity to the less privileged of the Long Beach community.

The following is a summary of additional activities achieved in 2008:

- a) A total of 94 events were sanctioned by the Sea Festival Association of Long Beach, Inc., in 2008; the operation of those events break down as follows:
 - 55 Events were promoted and operated by independent event operators.
 - ii. 39 events were operated in concert with the Department of Parks Recreation and Marine, of which:

12 were Thursday night Concerts in the Park

14 were Municipal Band Concerts, and

13 were events such as sailing on the American Pride.

- b) Long Beach, having established itself as THE new Southern California venue for beach volleyball in 2007, continued to see growth in that area with increased events from the Sinjin Smith Group and 2009 planning conversations with USA Volleyball.
- c) While the biennial Transpac Yacht Race did not operate in 2008, the California-Tahiti race was re-instated by the Transpac Yacht Club, and that together with the annual Mayor's Cup, the Ficker Cup and the numerous sabot events, continued to position and reconfirm Long Beach as the premier international sailing venue on the West Coast.
- d) Media coverage of the Sea Festival and Sea Festival events continued to grow, and almost doubled the results of 2007. Without exception, there was electronic coverage of Sea Festival events every weekend from the end of June through the first weekend of September. No longer do Sea Festival media staff have to explain to assignment editors "what is the Long Beach Sea Festival." Special sections and weekly full-page promotions were implemented by both the Press Telegram and the Grunion Gazette, together with Sea Festival logo'ed event coverage. Progress continues to be made with the Los Angeles Times and the Orange County Register, albeit sporadic.

- e) Once again, thanks to the assistance of Supervisor Don Knabe, the Department of Parks, Recreation and Marine, the Port of Long Beach and Charter Communications, over 6,000 youth from every City Council District in the city, participated in Sea Festival sanctioned events in 2008.
- f) Sea Festival continued to generate even greater numbers of hotel room nights at Long Beach hotels in 2008, surpassing the 4,344 room nights of 2007.
- g) Charter Communications, in their second year of their role as Presenting Title Sponsor of Sea Festival, increased their "activation" considerably by actively participating in numerous Sea Festival events. In particular Movies at the Beach was expanded to two locations in 2008, and the attendance numbers were double of those in 2007, averaging over 1,500 residents per night per venue.
- h) Sea Festival continued to work with Coca Cola to provide for on-site remote radio broadcasts from Long Beach events, a relationship which is expected to increase in 2009.
- i) Sea Festival, having signed the nation's largest powerboat magazine to a three year Presenting Sponsorship contract for the launch of the West Coast's first and only exclusive Offshore Powerboat Trade Show, continued to maximize that relationship and increase attendance and media coverage for the events of that weekend, the Catalina Ski Race, the Catalina Jet Ski Race, and the Long Beach to Catalina Offshore Challenge.
- j) In 2007, in concert with O Entertainment, Sea Festival sponsored the inaugural Crawfish Festival at Rainbow Lagoon. While 2007 was very successful, 2008 surpassed all expectations. Based upon the 2007 success, O Entertainment moved their annual Lobster Festival from Redondo Beach to Rainbow Lagoon, and yet again had another highly successful event.
- k) As part of the 2008 Sea Festival relationship with the Department of Environmental Services, a unique branding program was introduced at many Sea Festival events, "Recycle Long Beach" and "Litter Free Long Beach." In concert with the Long Beach Conservation Corps, the recycling program was implemented. It is planned to expand the program in 2009.
- Of importance to note was the successful operation by the Long Rowing Association, of the National Masters Championship at Marine Stadium; there is a tremendous potential that the Marine Stadium venue offers for other major rowing competitions that could greatly benefit the overall marketing position of the City of Long Beach to that particular sport.

1) 2008 was the first year of a "Strategic Operating Agreement" between the Sea Festival Association of Long Beach, Inc., and International City Racing, (ICR), operators of the successful Long Beach Marathon. Under the terms of the Agreement, ICR have assumed the responsibility for the day-to-day operation of Sea Festival, including event management, event public relations, sponsor fulfillment, and website management. Overall governance of the Sea Festival Association of Long Beach, Inc., remains with the company through the Board of Governors of the Sea Festival Association.

SUMMARY:

.Spectators and Participants:

As a result of the event survey forms which were completed by the event operators, the following data has been ascertained:

- 12,627 individuals "participated" in Sea Festival events.
- It is estimated that **258,300** individuals were "spectators" at Sea Festival events.

COMBINED TOTAL - 270,927

Of the "Combined Total," almost **46,000** individuals were declared to be from outside of Long Beach.

Economic Impact:

While no actual Economic Impact Study was conducted in 2008, event operators reported that they spent in excess of \$1 Million on equipment, staffing, and promotion.

Event operators report that an estimated **4,844 room nights** were spent in Long Beach hotels and motels by their participants/participant families and sponsors.

The above results would indicate a 7% increase in economic impact over 2007, as a result of Sea Festival activities in 2008.

Estimated Economic Impact of the 2008 Long Beach Sea Festival:-

To The City of Long Beach - \$5,976 Million

To the Region - \$10,045 Million

3. The Future:

- a) The Sea Festival Association of Long Beach is in the process of confirming 2009 event operators and their respective event dates. As of November 10, 2008, it would appear that all event operators are returning, and there are currently three additional requests for new events.
- b) There continues to be the need for a greater community outreach program. The availability of economical transportation for residents of west, central and north Long Beach continues to be a challenge. The single greatest limitation on getting increased numbers of youth to the beach and Sea Festival beach activities is transportation. Without the financial help from Supervisor Don Knabe's office to cover most of the cost of bus transportation, the 2007 program would have been 30% of what it actually was.
- c) More private sector sponsorship is needed in order to secure the financial viability of the annual Sea Festival.
- d) Event operators need to fully understand the value of their events being located in Long Beach, and the promotional value that Sea Festival delivers to them.
- Sea Festival needs to take on added responsibility of ensuring that event operators are complying with their Event Operating Permits and their Sea Festival sanction agreements.
- f) The value of the "Private/Public" partnership between the City of Long Beach and the Sea Festival Association needs to be enhanced in the media.
- g) Sea Festival needs to renegotiate their "Strategic Relationship" partnerships with the Press Telegram and Gazette newspapers, in order to provide value to Sea Festival as a result of the advertising expenditures made by Sea Festival sponsors.
- h) Sea Festival needs to enter into additional "community partnerships," similar to those of the Long Beach Junior Chamber of Commerce and Fred Hall Fishing Shows, in order to further grow the community events operated in concert with the Department of Parks Recreation and Marine.
- Sea Festival needs to "broaden" the make-up of its Board of Governors, in order to better understand and represent the needs of the various sectors of the total Long Beach community.
