EXAMPLES OF DUTIES: Under immediate supervision in a training capacity, develops qualifications for the position of Firefighter; receives academy instruction in Fire Department Policies and Procedures, firefighting, hazardous materials handling, rescue techniques, emergency medical procedures, physical fitness techniques, safety procedures, community relations, and operation of firefighting equipment; observes and interacts, under supervision, with Fire Department personnel in the performance of firefighting and medical emergency duties; and performs training and/or administrative duties as required.

REQUIREMENTS TO FILE:

Qualified candidates must satisfy requirements **A**, **B**, and **C** by the filing deadline, December 22, 2017:

- A. A valid driver's license.
- B. Eighteen (18) years of age or older.
- C. High school diploma or GED equivalency.

- **Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) Certificate or National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians (NREMT) Certification required at time of final selection/appointment to the Fire Recruit Academy.**

Completion of the FireTeam entry-level, firefighter examination is required. **All testing must be completed through National Testing Network (NTN) by January 5, 2018.** Applicants are encouraged to visit the website nationaltestingnetwork.com for more information and to schedule a testing date as soon as possible.

Completion of a City of Long Beach job application is also required and will be available 7:30 a.m., December 18, 2017 through 4:30 p.m., December 22, 2017. Applicants are encouraged to complete their testing through NTN before the application filing period.

A fee is required to take the FireTeam examination. Limited fee waivers are available through the City of Long Beach, **on a first come, first served basis. Proof of financial need is required.**

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

Ability to:

- read, comprehend, and retain technical training materials;
- endure strenuous physical activity requiring good balance, coordination, flexibility, and strength;
- make effective decisions; promote teamwork and effective human relations skills;
- effectively communicate orally and in writing.

Willingness to: comply with Long Beach Fire Department’s Policies and Procedures, including grooming standards.

A physical examination to include medical history and physical examination screening for heart and lung function, blood and urine tests, and supplemental testing as required to determine that the applicant is free of disqualifying medical conditions as described in the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) 1582 Standard on Medical Requirements.

DESIRABLE QUALIFICATIONS: Paramedic certification; bilingual English/Spanish or English/ Southeast Asian language skills; and college level Fire Science coursework/degree.

A minimum rating of 70 must be attained in each part of the examination. Candidates passing all phases of the examination will be placed on the eligible list. Certification by score bands may be considered based on an analysis of test results.

The Long Beach Fire Department will require successful completion of the Biddle Consolidated Physical Ability Test (PAT) prior to conditional offer of employment. After a conditional offer of employment, candidates will be required to pass a reference check, thorough background investigation, and a job-related medical examination.

In support of the City’s Language Access Policy, bilingual skills (Spanish, Khmer or Tagalog) are desirable for some positions interacting with the public.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES: Under general supervision, develops, implements, and coordinates nutrition services provided to participants in public health nutrition programs; develops and implements programs designed to improve nutrition of patients through changed dietary practices in the Women, Infants and Children's Program; provides nutrition assessments, food and diet information, and breastfeeding education and support to the public by means of class sessions and individual counseling; consults with Health Department staff on specific food and nutrition problems; visits neighborhood facility centers to provide training and counseling on a decentralized basis; develops educational materials and protocols for nutrition program participants; conducts training for department staff, and community organizations; develops high risk nutrition intervention plans and documents in the Management Information System (MIS); prepares or assembles written and/or audiovisual material as aids in training and counseling sessions; determines individual and group nutrition practices by determining cultural preferences and dietary patterns; conducts studies and surveys of nutrient consumption, nutrition assessment and education, and other factors affecting nutrition practice; may conduct scheduled participant file audits as part of the Continuous Quality Improvement (CQI) program; may coordinate programs with community organizations and others in the Health Department to provide nutrition expertise; may act in lead/supervisory capacity; performs other related duties as assigned.

REQUIREMENTS TO FILE:

Applicants must meet the following requirements listed below:

- Graduation with a Bachelor's degree from an accredited four-year college or university with a major in Public Health Nutrition, Dietetics, or related field **(proof required)***.
- **AND**
- Current status as a Registered Dietician **(proof required*)** or current status as a Registered Eligible Nutritionist and must pass Registered Dietitian Nutritionist Exam within 6 months of hiring. **(proof required*)**

Additional Requirements:

- Ability to communicate effectively and deal tactfully with clients of diverse ethnic, cultural, and economic backgrounds.
- Ability to operate a personal computer and/or other information systems.
- Willingness to work evenings or weekends as required.

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- A valid motor vehicle operator license. (A DMV H6 10-year driver history printout must be submitted to the hiring department prior to onboarding).

***Required documents, such as degree or transcripts, must be uploaded to the online application at the time of filing. Any proofs submitted must contain either the applicant's name or other identifying characteristic on the form. Candidates who possess degrees from colleges or universities from outside the United States must attach proof of educational equivalence at the time of filing.**

DESIRABLE QUALIFICATIONS: Bilingual skills (Spanish, Khmer, or Tagalog). Knowledge of Women, Infants, and Children program (WIC).

This examination will be conducted using the continuous, non-competitive procedure. All applicants meeting the minimum requirements to file will be placed on the eligible list, with those receiving Veteran's Credit first and then in the order in which applications were filed.
