



Clean Long Beach Initiative – 2017 Summary

- Over 2,100 tons of debris collected
- Collected over 15,000 mattresses
- Abated 1.25 million sq. ft. of graffiti
- 116 Concentrated alley cleanups
- Over 300 litter and scavenging citations issued
- 195 homeless encampment cleanups
- Over 150 neighborhood cleanups supported
