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3	A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4	CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION
5	FOR THE AFFORDABLE HOUSING AND SUSTAINABLE
6	COMMUNITIES PROGRAM
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8	WHEREAS, the State of California, the Strategic Growth Council (SGC) and
9	the Department of Housing and Community Development (Department) have issued a
10	Notice of Funding Availability dated October 2, 2017 (NOFA), under the Affordable Housing
11	and Sustainable Communities (AHSC) Program established under Division 44, Part 1 of
12	the Public Resources Code commencing with Section 75200; and
13	WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach desires to apply for the AHSC Program
14	funds and submit the application package released by the Department for the AHSC
15	Program; and
16	WHEREAS, the SGC is authorized to approve funding allocations for the
17	AHSC Program, subject to the terms and conditions of the NOFA, AHSC Program
18	guidelines, application package, and standard agreement; and
19	WHEREAS, the Department is authorized to administer the approved funding
20	allocations of the AHSC Program;
21	NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
22	follows:
23	Section 1. The City of Long Beach (Applicant) is hereby authorized and
24	directed to apply for and submit to the Department the AHSC Program Application as
25	detailed in the NOFA dated October 2, 2017, for Round 3 in a total amount not to exceed
26	\$15,750,000 of which \$10,450,000 is requested as a loan for an Affordable Housing
27	Development (AHD) ("AHSC Loan") and \$5,300,000 is requested for a grant for Housing-
28	Related Infrastructure (HRI), Sustainable Transportation Infrastructure (STI), Transit-

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Related Amenities(TRA) or Program (PGM) activities ("AHSC Grant") as defined the AHSC 1 2 Program Guidelines adopted by SGC on July 17, 2017 errata August 14, 2017. If the application is approved, the Applicant is hereby authorized and directed to enter into, 3 execute, and deliver a State of California Standard Agreement (Standard Agreement) in a 4 total amount not to exceed \$15,750,000 (\$10,450,000 for the AHSC Loan and \$5,300,000 5 for the AHSC Grant), and any and all other documents required or deemed necessary or 6 appropriate to secure the AHSC Program funds from the Department, and all amendments 7 8 thereto (collectively, the "AHSC Documents").

Applicant shall be subject to the terms and conditions as 9 Section 2. specified in the Standard Agreement. Funds are to be used for allowable capital asset 10 project expenditures to be identified in Exhibit "A" of the Standard Agreement. The 11 application in full is incorporated as part of the Standard Agreement. Any and all activities 12 funded, information provided, and timelines represented in the application are enforceable 13 14 through the Standard Agreement. Applicant hereby agrees to use the funds for eligible capital asset(s) in the manner presented in the application as approved by the Department 15 and in accordance with the NOFA and Program Guidelines and Application Package. 16

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute in
the name of the Applicant the AHSC Program Application Package and the AHSC Program
Documents as required by the Department for participation in the AHSC Program.

20 Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption 21 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.

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
