Today, the City received the attached Notice of Termination for the Lease Agreement between the City of Long Beach and Long Beach Memorial Medical Center dated April 29, 2011 (Lease Agreement). The letter from Memorial Medical Center (LBMMC) provides formal notification that LBMMC is exercising its 120-day termination rights under the Lease Agreement to operate Community Hospital Long Beach (Community Hospital) at the City-owned property at 1720 Termino Avenue. The effective date of termination is July 3, 2018.

As directed by the City Council, staff will continue to identify partners to meet State requirements and sustain, if possible, the emergency department at Community Hospital. Thank you for your support in this effort.

The termination date of the Lease Agreement will be July 3, 2018, which, as required under Section 3.F, is 120 days from March 5th, the date of the City's receipt of this notice. LBMMC plans to work closely with the City to ensure a smooth transition of the property and to clarify the City's intentions with regard to the medical office building at 1760 Termino Avenue, which is also subject to the Lease Agreement.
