	24	Section 5. The polls for the General Municipal Election shall be open at
	25	7:00 a.m. and shall be kept open until 8:00 p.m. when the polls shall be closed; except
	26	that, if at the hour of closing there are any voters in the polling place or in line at the door
	27	who are qualified to vote, and who have not been able to do so since appearing, the polls
	28	shall be kept open a sufficient time to enable them to vote; but no one who arrives at the
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polling place after 8:00 p.m. shall be entitled to vote, although the polls may be open 1 2 when such person arrives.

California Elections Code Section 13307 requires that a 3 Section 6. candidate's statement must be translated in Spanish at the candidate's request. Further, 4 in accordance with the requirements of the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965 (PL 94-73) 5 all candidates' statements shall be translated into the languages indicated for Member of 6 the City Council for the Fifth and Seventh Council Districts as follows: Khmer, Korean, 8 Spanish, Tagalog, and Vietnamese. Any translations into the required languages shall be available in the City Clerk's office upon request. A candidate shall not be required to 9 10 pay for the cost of translating his or her candidate's statement into any foreign language required pursuant to federal and/or state law. However, a candidate shall be required to pay the cost of printing the candidate's statement in the sample ballot pamphlet in a 12 13 foreign language.

Pursuant to Section 13307 of the California Elections Code, a 14 Section 7. charge shall be levied against each candidate for the costs of the candidate's statements 15 sent to each voter. The City Clerk is directed and authorized to establish and implement 16 the charge for the costs of printing, handling, translating, and mailing any candidate 17 statements as provided in Elections Code Section 13307. Any allegation of indigency or 18 19 inability to pay the requisite fee in advance shall be handled by the City Clerk in 20 accordance with the provisions of Elections Code Section 13309, and in such instances the candidate's statement shall only be published in the English/Spanish language. 21

Candidates will have up to five (5) days following the April 10, 22 Section 8. 23 2018 Primary Nominating Election to change their candidate statement.

24 Section 9. The City Clerk shall provide each candidate or the candidate's 25 representative with a copy of the resolution.

26 Section 10. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption 27 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
