RES-18-0186 2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE 3 4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY 5 MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH INFOR PUBLIC SECTOR, INC., WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR 6 7 BIDS, FOR RHYTHM FOR CIVICS SOFTWARE, IN AN 8 ANNUAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$30,000 FOR A 9 PERIOD OF THREE YEARS 10 11 WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach, Section 1801, permits the City Manager to enter into a contract on behalf of the City, in writing or otherwise, without 12 13 advertising for bids, for services, supplies, materials, equipment or labor for actual 14 emergency work when authorized by resolution; and 15 WHEREAS, in February 2015, the Department of Development Services 16 received Council approval to enter into an agreement with e-PlanSoft for the purchase of 17 electronic plan check software; and 18 WHEREAS, the electronic plan check system would provide a convenient 19 way for applicants and City staff to submit, review, and approve construction plans online 20 by way of a web portal; and 21 WHEREAS, the implementation of this electronic plan check system is being 22 conducted in two phases: the first phase was to implement the stand-alone electronic plan 23 check software and the second phase will include the implementation of a new online web 24 portal where customers can submit electronic plans online; and 25 WHEREAS, a key component of the second phase is the is the use of the 26 Infor Public Sector, Inc. ("Infor") software as a service solution, Rhythm for Civics; and 27 WHEREAS, Rhythm for Civics is an Infor proprietary solution developed by Infor for the Infor Public Sector back office solution therefore, no useful purpose would be 28

served by advertising for bids and to do so would constitute an idle and useless act and
 unnecessary expenditure of public funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Infor Public Sector, Inc., without advertising for bids, for the purchase, delivery, and implementation of Rhythm for Civics software in an annual amount not to exceed Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000) for a period of three (3) years, with the option to renew for one (1) additional three-year period, at the discretion of the City Manager.

10Section 2.This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption11by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
