RECOMMENDATION:

Recommendation to authorize the City Attorney to submit Stipulations with Request for Award for approval by the Workers' Compensation Appeals Board, and if so approved, authority to pay \$56,260.00 in compliance with the Appeals Board Order for Bradley Liebeck.

DISCUSSION:

Bradley Liebeck has made a claim for injuries allegedly sustained in the course of his employment with the City of Long Beach. The Economic Development and Finance Committee on January 22, 2019, approved the submission to the Workers' Compensation Appeals Board of Stipulations with Request for Award by the City and Bradley Liebeck, based upon a 39 percent disability rating, with provision for lifetime medical care as may be necessary.
