RECOMMENDATION:

Receive the supporting documentation into the record, conclude the public hearing, and grant an Entertainment Permit with conditions on the application of Shamrock Hospitality Group, LLC, dba Muldoon's Saloon, 5646 Paramount Boulevard, for entertainment without dancing. (District 8)

DISCUSSION

The Long Beach Municipal Code (LBMC) requires an application be filed and a hearing be held before the City Council whenever this type of activity is requested and before an entertainment permit (Permit) is granted or denied.

The LBMC also requires the City Council to approve the issuance of the Permit if they find that: the issuance of the Permit at the proposed location is consistent with federal, state and local laws, rules, and regulations; it will not constitute an undue burden on the neighborhood; the applicant(s) or responsible persons have not been convicted of any misdemeanor involving moral turpitude or felony offense within the past five years; and, neither the applicant(s) or any responsible persons have a history of committing significant violations of the City code and have not provided false or misleading information on their application.

The City Council has the authority to approve the following options: 1) grant the Permit, with or without conditions; or 2) deny the Permit on the application. Once the Permit is granted, pursuant to LBMC 5.72.120.5, the Permit will be subject to an administrative review by the Financial Management Department every two years. This review process will consist of a multi-department analysis to determine compliance and identify if issues exist. This provision does not affect the City's ability to modify, revoke or suspend a permit at any time.

City departments have conducted their investigations in accordance with the LBMC. Attached are the departmental investigative reports, history, entertainment permit application, and floor plan.

The following summarizes departmental findings:

- The Police Department recommends the permit for entertainment without dancing be approved subject to the tiered conditions.
- The Fire Department finds the building/location meets department requirements for the proposed use.
- The Health and Human Services Department finds the building/location meets department requirements for the proposed use with the condition that the establishment remain in compliance with the Long Beach Noise Ordinance (LBMC Chapter 8.80).
- The Development Services Department finds the building/location meets department requirements for the proposed use.

The Financial Management Department, Business Services Bureau, has reviewed all submitted department documents and correspondence and, after a thorough review, recommends that the permit for entertainment without dancing be approved subject to conditions (attached).

In the event that any of the recommended conditions are in conflict with other permits or licenses, the permittee shall adhere to the strictest of the applicable conditions. This location has been licensed as a Bar, Tavern, Lounge since November 1984. The business changed ownership to Shamrock Hospitality Group, LLC, in July 2016.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Amy R. Webber on August 30, 2018.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

The hearing date of September 18, 2018, has been posted on the business location, with the applicant and property owners within 300 feet notified by mail.

FISCAL IMPACT

The following fees were collected with the application: Building Review \$22.45 and Zoning Review \$33.00 (Development Services), Police Investigation \$1,280.00 (Police Department), Mailing List \$90.00 (Financial Management Department).

The following fees will be collected if the application is approved: Business License Annual Tax \$365.17, Employee Rate \$18.96 per employee, and Annual Entertainment Regulatory Fee \$310.00 (Financial Management Department).

Recommended Conditions of Operation Shamrock Hospitality Group LLC DBA Muldoon's Saloon 5646 Paramount Blvd. Application for Entertainment Without Dancing

The Department of Financial Management recommends **approval** of the Permit subject to the following conditions:

I. STANDARD CONDITIONS OF OPERATION

- 1) The operation of the establishment shall be limited to those activities and elements expressly indicated on the permit application and approved by the City Council. Any change in the operation, which exceeds the conditions of the approved permit, will require that a new permit application be submitted to the City Council for their review and approval.
- 2) Unless separately applied for, reviewed, and approved, no adult entertainment, as defined by Section 5.72.115(B) LBMC, shall be conducted on the permitted premises.
- 3) The establishment shall remain in compliance with all applicable sections of the Long Beach Noise Ordinance (LMBC Chapter 8.80).
- 4) Due to the proximity of neighboring businesses and residences, all door(s) and windows shall be kept closed at all times during any entertainment, except in cases of emergency and to permit deliveries. Said door(s) is not to consist solely of a screen or ventilated security door. Sound shall not be audible beyond fifty feet (50') from the exterior of the premises in any direction. Outdoor amplified entertainment is prohibited.
- 5) The permittee shall not allow employees to discard trash or beer bottles into the outside dumpster between the hours of 10:00 P.M. and 7:00 A.M.
- 6) Deliveries to and from the premises shall be limited to the hours of 8:00 A.M. to 10:00 P.M.
- 7) The permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) uniformed security guard during all times that the entertainment activities are being conducted for crowds up to fifty (50) people. For crowds over fifty (50) people, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) additional uniformed security guard per fifty (50) people. Patrons awaiting entry in a defined queue shall be counted toward the calculation of required security staffing levels.

The attire of each security guard shall clearly indicate the guard's affiliation with the establishment by means of a pin, shirt, or other visible form of identification. Should the permittee's operations give rise to a substantial increase in complaint/calls for police service, or trash left in the parking lot, the permittee shall increase security staff, implement the use of electronic metal detection equipment, increase outside

lighting, or make other changes to the premises or operation as the Chief of Police determines are necessary to protect the safety of the public.

- 8) Interior lighting shall be sufficient to make easily discernible the appearance and conduct of all persons and patrons inside the business.
- 9) The permittee shall take reasonable measures to prohibit and prevent the loitering of persons immediately outside any of the entrance/exit doors and the parking lot, at all times while open for business and at the conclusion of each event. This should be done by use of security guards and signage indicating words to the effect of, "Please respect our neighbors" or something similar.
- 10) The permittee shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the premises and the area adjacent to the licensed premises over which they have control.
- 11) The permittee agrees to reimburse the City for all costs associated with excessive police services, as determined by the Chief of Police, required as the result of any incident or nuisance arising out of or in connection with the permittee's operations.
- 12) Current occupancy loads shall be posted at all times, and the permittee shall have an effective system to keep count of the number of occupants present at any given time and provide that information to public safety personnel upon request. (LBMC section 18.48.320).
- 13) Any graffiti painted or marked upon the premises, or on any adjacent area under the control of the licensee, shall be removed or painted over within 24 hours of being applied.
- 14) The business, or agents, shall not distribute any advertising matter such as signs, posters, or promotional cards, in or upon any public property, or in or on any vehicle in any such place in the City. Distribution of any advertising matter upon private property shall adhere to the following guidelines: By placing the same matter in a receptacle, clip, or other device designed or intended to receive advertising matter. The permittee shall keep all promoter contracts, including names, addresses, and phone numbers, on file at all times, and be available for inspection at any time.
- 15) The parking lot shall be equipped with lighting of sufficient power to illuminate and make easily discernible the appearance and conduct of all persons on or about the parking lot. The position of such lighting shall not disturb the normal privacy and use of any neighboring residences.
- 16) The permittee shall install and maintain a video surveillance system that monitors no less than the front and rear of the business with full view of the public right-ofways and any parking lot under the control of the permittee. The video system must be capable of delineating on playback the activity and physical features of persona and areas within the premises. Recordings shall be retained for a minimum of 30 days and be accessible via the Internet by the Long Beach Police Department. A Public Internet Protocol (IP) address and user name/password is also required to allow the Long Beach Police Department to view live and recorded video from

these cameras over the internet. All video security cameras shall be installed to the satisfaction of the Chief of Police, Director of Technology Services, and Director of Development Services. At the discretion of the Chief of Police, the permittee may be required to add additional video cameras.

- 17) The permittee shall ensure all employees attend an alcohol awareness class, such as the LEAD program offered by the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control, within the first ninety (90) days of employment. In the event that the LEAD program class is not offered within this ninety day period, the permittee shall attend the next available class. Proof of completion shall be kept on file at the business and be available for inspection at any time.
- 18) The permittee shall maintain full compliance with all applicable laws, ABC laws, ordinances, and stated conditions. In the event of a conflict with the requirements of this permit, your conditional use permit, or your Alcoholic Beverage Control license, the more stringent regulation shall apply.

II. ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS OF OPERATION

- 1) Tiered Conditions. "Tiered Conditions" as set forth below consist of progressively more stringent regulations on entertainment and related activities. By applying for this entertainment permit, the applicant has agreed to the conditions set forth below and has agreed to waive a hearing if these conditions are applied. The City Council may add further conditions not listed here, or revoke the permit, if Permittee does not comply with the conditions imposed in this permit. These conditions do not modify or limit in any way the authority of the Chief of Police to enforce Penal Code Section 415 (disturbing the peace) against any person, or of the Chief of Police or the Fire Marshal to immediately take action in the event of an imminent threat to public health or safety.
 - a. Tier 1: Entertainment activities indicated on Page 9 of your entertainment application shall be restricted to 10:00 PM to 1:00 AM, Wednesday through Saturday, including holidays.
 - b. Tier 2: Following the receipt of three (3) or more noise complaints that require a response by the Police Department within a 30-day period and which are found to violate the noise standard prohibiting unreasonably loud sound fifty feet (50') from the perimeter of the premises, Permittee will be notified that his or her premises must comply with those Tier 2 Noise Conditions which the City determines are necessary to protect the public peace and to comply with the City's noise ordinance by reducing the hours of entertainment to 10:00 PM to 12:00 AM, Wednesday through Saturday in addition to any additional measures deemed necessary by the Chief of Police or the Fire Marshal to protect health and safety.
 - c. Tier 3: If operating under Tier 2 Noise Conditions and following the receipt of three (3) or additional noise complaints that require a response

by the Police Department within a 30-day period and which are found to violate the noise standard prohibiting unreasonably loud sound fifty feet (50') from the perimeter of the premises, Permittee will be notified that his or her premises must comply with those Tier 3 Noise Conditions which the City determines are necessary to protect the public peace and to comply with the City's noise ordinance by reducing the hours of entertainment to 10:00 PM to 11:00 PM, Wednesday through Saturday in addition to any additional measures deemed necessary by the Chief of Police or the Fire Marshal to protect health and safety.

- d. Upon the request of a Permittee who has been required to implement Tier 2 or Tier 3 conditions, the Chief of Police, in consultation with the Fire Marshal and the Health Department, shall review Permittee's recent compliance history and determine whether some or all conditions can be returned to Tier 1 or Tier 2 levels consistent with the protection of public health and safety.
- 2) No owner, operator or manager shall permit any person under the age of 21 years of age within the premises at any time.
- 3) The permittee shall ensure the security guard(s) monitor and check the adjacent property and parking lots on an hourly basis after 8:00 p.m. each night entertainment is provided. Security shall maintain order and prevent the unlawful consumption of alcohol and prevent any activity that would interfere with the quiet enjoyment of any nearby residential property.
- 4) Alcoholic beverages shall not be consumed on any property adjacent to the premises.
- III. In the event that any of the recommended conditions attached to any permit or license is in conflict, the permittee shall adhere to the strictest of the applicable conditions. In addition, please be advised that your permit is subject to administrative review every two years from the date this permit is issued. If grounds exist for modification, revocation, or suspension of the permit, a hearing will be held.

Subject: APPLICATION FOR AN ENTERTAINMENT WITHOUT DANCING PERMIT AT MULDOON'S SALOON – 5646 NORTH PARAMOUNT BOULEVARD

In response to your request for a recommendation regarding the above named permit application for Entertainment <u>without</u> Dancing, the Police Department recommends **approval** of an Entertainment without Dancing Permit, subject to the following conditions:

Muldoon's Saloon is located at 5646 Paramount Boulevard, and is owned and operated by John English and Patrick Conlen. In August 2016, Shamrock Hospitality Group, LLC was issued a Type 48 (On-Sale General Public Premises) Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) license. On May 17, 2017, Patrick Conlon applied for an Entertainment without Dancing Permit requesting live music by more than two performers, live and recorded amplified music, a disc jockey, and karaoke Wednesday through Saturday from 10:00 PM until 1:00 AM.

Based upon the crime analysis, Vice Section's investigation, and the North Division Patrol Commander's recommendation, the Long Beach Police Department has determined the public's peace, safety, and welfare would not be adversely impacted by the issuance of this permit, provided the appropriate conditions are imposed and observed by the applicant.

CONDITIONS OF OPERATION

- 1) The operation of the establishment shall be limited to those activities and elements expressly indicated on the permit application and approved by the City Council. Any change in the operation, which exceeds the conditions of the approved permit, will require that a new permit application be submitted to the City Council for their review and approval.
- 2) Unless separately applied for, reviewed, and approved, no adult entertainment, as defined by section 5.72.115(B) LBMC shall be conducted on the permitted premises.
- 3) Entertainment activities indicated on page #9 of your entertainment application shall be restricted from 10:00 PM to 1:00 AM Wednesday through Saturday.
- 4) Entertainment on the following holidays is permitted until 1:00 AM on New Year's Eve, New Year's Day, St. Patrick's Day, Cinco de Mayo, July 4th, and Halloween night.

- 5) No owner, operator, or manager shall permit any person under the age of twenty-one (21) years within the premises, at any time, during the hours of operation.
- 6) The establishment shall remain in compliance with all applicable sections of the Long Beach Noise Ordinance (LBMC Chapter 8.80).
- 7) Due to the proximity of neighboring businesses and residences, all door(s) and window(s) shall be kept closed at all times during any musical entertainment, except in cases of emergency, and to permit deliveries. Said door(s) shall not consist solely of a screen or ventilated security door. Sound shall not be audible beyond fifty feet (50') from the exterior of the premises in any direction.
- 8) The permittee shall not allow employees to discard trash or beer bottles into the outside dumpster between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.
- 9) The permittee shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the premises and the area adjacent to the licensed premises over which they have control.
- 10) Any graffiti painted or marked upon the premises, or on any adjacent area under the control of the licensee, shall be removed or painted over within 24 hours of being applied.
- 11) Interior lighting shall be sufficient to make easily discernible the appearance and conduct of all persons and patrons inside the business.
- 12) The permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) licensed security guard during all times that the entertainment activities are being conducted for crowds up to fifty (50) people. For crowds over fifty (50) people, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) additional security guard per fifty (50) people. Patrons awaiting entry in a defined queue shall be counted toward the calculation of required security staffing levels.

The attire of each security guard shall clearly indicate the guard's affiliation with the establishment by means of a pin, shirt, or other visible form of identification. Should the permittee's operations give rise to a substantial increase in complaint/calls for police service, or trash left in the parking lot, the permittee shall increase security staff, implement the use of electronic metal detection equipment, increase outside lighting, or make other changes to the premises or operation as the Chief of Police determines are necessary to protect the safety of the public.

- 13) At the conclusion of each event, the permittee shall take reasonable measures to ensure that exiting patrons walk directly to their vehicles and not loiter in the parking lot or the immediate area.
- 14) The permittee shall ensure a security guard monitor and check the property adjacent to, and the parking lots, on an hourly basis after 8:00 PM each night of the week while entertainment is provided. Security shall maintain order and prevent the unlawful consumption of alcohol and prevent any activity that would interfere with the quiet enjoyment of any nearby residential property.
- 15) The parking lot shall be equipped with lighting of sufficient power to illuminate and make easily discernible the appearance and conduct of all persons on or about the parking lot. The position of the lighting shall not disturb the normal privacy and use of any neighboring residences.
- 16) The permittee shall take reasonable measures to prohibit and prevent the loitering of persons immediately outside any of the entrance/exit doors and the parking lot, at all times while open for business. This should be done by utilizing security guards and signage with verbiage such as, "Please respect our neighbors", or something similar.
- 17) If any trash, noise, or disturbance complaints are located in the parking lot and/or surrounding area of the business can be attributed to the operation of said business, the Long Beach Police Department can determine and impose requirements for security officer(s) to routinely monitor and handle these problems.
- 18) Current occupancy loads shall be posted at all times, and the permittee shall have an effective system to keep count of the number of occupants present at any given time. This information shall be provided to public safety personnel upon request.
- 19) The permittee agrees to reimburse the City of Long Beach whenever excessive police services, as determined by the Chief of Police, are required as the result of any incident or nuisance arising out of, or in connection with the permittee's operations.
- 20) Alcoholic beverages shall not be consumed on any property adjacent to the premises.
- 21) Muldoon's Saloon, or its agents, shall not distribute any advertising matter such as signs, posters, or promotional cards, in or upon any public property, any vehicle or in any other such place in the City of Long Beach. Distribution of any advertising matter upon private property shall adhere to the following guidelines: By placing the same matter in a receptacle, clip, or other device designed or intended to receive advertising matter. The permittee shall keep

> all promoter contracts, including names, addresses, and phone numbers, on file at all times, and be available for inspection at any time.

- 22) The permittee shall maintain full compliance with all applicable laws, ABC laws, ordinances, and stated conditions. In the event of a conflict between the requirements of this permit, your conditional use permit, or your Alcoholic Beverage Control license, the more stringent regulation shall apply.
- 23) The permittee shall be responsible for installing and maintaining a video surveillance system that monitors no less than the front and rear of the business, with full view of the public right-of-ways, and any parking lot under the control of the permittee. These cameras shall record video for a minimum of 30 days and be accessible via the Internet by the Long Beach Police Department. A Public Internet Protocol (IP) address and user name/password is also required to allow the Long Beach Police Department to view live and recorded video from these cameras over the internet. All video security cameras shall be installed to the satisfaction of the Chief of Police, Director of Technology Services, and Director of Development Services. At the discretion of the Chief of Police, the permittee may be required to add additional video cameras
- 24) The permittee shall ensure that all employees attend an alcohol awareness class such as TIPS or LEAD, within the first ninety (90) days of employment. The permittee shall keep employee's proof of completion on file, and be available for inspection at any time.

II. ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS OF OPERATION

- 1) Tiered Conditions. "Tiered Conditions" as set forth below consist of progressively more stringent regulations on entertainment and related activities. By applying for this entertainment permit, the applicant has agreed to the conditions set forth below and has agreed to waive a hearing if these conditions are applied. The City Council may add further conditions not listed here, or revoke the permit, if Permittee does not comply with the conditions imposed in this permit. These conditions do not modify or limit in any way the authority of the Chief of Police to enforce Penal Code Section 415 (disturbing the peace) against any person, or of the Chief of Police or the Fire Marshal to immediately take action in the event of an imminent threat to public health or safety.
- a. Tier 1: Entertainment activities indicated on Page 9 of your entertainment application shall be restricted to 10:00 PM to 1:00 AM, Wednesday through Saturday
- b. Tier 2: Following the receipt of three (3) or more noise complaints that require a response by the Police Department within a 30-day period and which are found to violate the noise standard prohibiting unreasonably loud

> sound fifty feet (50') from the perimeter of the premises, Permittee will be notified that his or her premises must comply with those Tier 2 Noise Conditions which the City determines are necessary to protect the public peace and to comply with the City's noise ordinance by reducing the hours of entertainment to 10:00 PM to 12:00 PM, Wednesday through Saturday in addition to any additional measures deemed necessary by the Chief of Police or the Fire Marshal to protect health and safety.

- c. Tier 3: If operating under Tier 2 Noise Conditions and following the receipt of three (3) or additional noise complaints that require a response by the Police Department within a 30-day period and which are found to violate the noise standard prohibiting unreasonably loud sound fifty feet (50') from the perimeter of the premises, Permittee will be notified that his or her premises must comply with those Tier 3 Noise Conditions which the City determines are necessary to protect the public peace and to comply with the City's noise ordinance by reducing the hours of entertainment to 10:00 PM to 11:00 PM, Wednesday through Saturday in addition to any additional measures deemed necessary by the Chief of Police or the Fire Marshal to protect health and safety.
- d. Upon the request of a Permittee who has been required to implement Tier 2 or Tier 3 conditions, the Chief of Police, in consultation with the Fire Marshal and the Health Department, shall review Permittee's recent compliance history and determine whether some or all conditions can be returned to Tier 1 or Tier 2 levels consistent with the protection of public health and safety
- III. In the event that any of the recommended conditions attached to any permit or license is in conflict, the permittee shall adhere to the strictest of the applicable conditions. In addition, please be advised that your permit is subject to administrative review every two years from the date this permit is issued. If grounds exist for revocation or suspension of the permit, a hearing will be held.

The Police Department recommends **approval** of this application for an Entertainment <u>without</u> Dancing Permit, by Shamrock Hospitality Group, LLC, dba Muldoon's Saloon, located at 5646 North Paramount Boulevard, subject to the conditions provided in the attached memorandum.

Background

Muldoon's Saloon is located at 5646 Paramount Boulevard, and is owned and operated by John English and Patrick Conlen. In August 2016, Shamrock Hospitality Group, LLC was issued a Type 48 (On-Sale General Public Premises) Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) license. On May 17, 2017, Patrick Conlon applied for an Entertainment without Dancing Permit requesting live music by more than two performers, live and recorded amplified music, a disc jockey, and karaoke Wednesday through Saturday from 10:00 PM until 1:00 AM.

Crime Analysis

As part of this investigation, Vice Detectives examined calls for service, crime reports, and arrests at the above location for a two-year period from May 17, 2016 to May 17, 2018. The report indicated 15 calls for service, four incidents, and zero arrests attributable to the business. For further details, see Crystal Report analysis.

Patrol Division

North Division Patrol Commander Steve Lauricella was contacted for an opinion regarding the issuance of this permit. Commander S. Lauricella stated patrol officers have not had problems at the location and are not aware of any negative incidents attributable to the business. Commander S. Lauricella has no objections to the proposed entertainment and does not believe the issuance of an entertainment permit will have an adverse impact on Patrol Division resources.

Vice Investigations

As part of this investigation, Vice Detectives went to this location and observed no residences within 100 feet of the business. Detectives also went to this location in an undercover capacity on two separate occasions:

On Thursday, May 3, 2018, at approximately 9:30 PM, Vice Detectives went to the location. There was no security guard at the front door checking identification. There were approximately 20 patrons inside the location drinking alcoholic beverages and listening to music. The music inside from a live band was very loud. The music could be heard from outside of the business and no violations were observed.

On Wednesday, May 10, 2018, at approximately 9:30 hours, detectives went to the location. There were approximately 15 patrons inside the business drinking alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages, socializing and playing pool. The music could be heard from outside of the business and no violations were observed.

Vice detectives also met with the owners at the establishment. They discussed the proposed entertainment activities, where entertainment activities will take place and the conditions the Police Department will recommend for the Entertainment without Dancing Permit.

Recommendation

Based on the Vice Section's investigation, the Long Beach Police Department has found the public peace, safety, and welfare would not be impaired by the issuance of this permit, provided the appropriate conditions are imposed and observed by the applicant. The Police Department recommends **approval** of the requested permit, subject to the conditions provided in the attached memorandum.
