Section 6. Chapter 5.92, "Adult-Use Cannabis Businesses and Activities" is added to the Long Beach Municipal Code as shown on the attached Exhibit "F".

Section 7. Section 21.15.113 is added to the Long Beach Municipal Code to read as follows:

21.15.113 Adult-Use Cannabis Dispensary.

A retail use (SIC Code 59) where cannabis goods or devices for the use of cannabis goods are offered, either individually or in any combination, for retail sale to customers at an on-site fixed location, including an establishment that also offers delivery of cannabis goods as part of a retail sale, in addition to on-site sales, in compliance with Title 5.90 and 5.92.

Section 8. Sections 21.15.441.1, 21.15.441.2, 21.15.441.3, and 21.15.441.4 are added to the Long Beach Municipal Code to read as follows: 21.15.441.1 Cannabis cultivation.

An industrial use (SIC Code 072) that engaged in the commercial cultivation of cannabis, and all associated commercial cultivation activities involved in the cultivation of cannabis, pursuant to this Chapter, including a nursery which produces clones, immature plants, seeds, or other agricultural products specifically for the planting, propagation, and cultivation of cannabis.

21.15.441.2 Cannabis manufacturing/processing.

An industrial use (SIC Code 283) engaged in the production, conversion, preparation, propagation, deriving, processing, or compounding of cannabis goods either directly or indirectly or by extraction methods, or independently by means of chemical synthesis, or by a combination of extraction and chemical synthesis at a fixed location that packages or repackages cannabis goods or labels or relabels its container.

21.15.441.3 Cannabis distribution.

An industrial use (SIC Code 42) engaged in the business of the distribution of cannabis goods between licensed cannabis facilities. 21.15.441.4 Cannabis testing.

A professional service use (SIC Code 873) that offers or performs tests of cannabis goods and that is ISO/IEC 17025 accredited, or pending ISO/IEC 17025 accreditation, and licensed by the California Bureau of Cannabis Control that provides independent testing of marijuana or marijuana products.

Section 9. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance by the City Council and cause it to be posted in three (3) conspicuous places in the City of Long Beach, and it shall take effect on the thirty-first (31st) day after it is approved by the Mayor.
