3	A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE			
4	CITY OF LONG BEACH ELECTING TO BE EXEMPT FROM			
5	THE CONGESTION MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

7	WHEREAS, in 1990, the voters of California passed Proposition 111 and			
8	the requirement that urbanized counties develop and implement a Congestion			
9	Management Program ("CMP"); and			
10	WHEREAS, the legislature and Governor established the specific			
11	requirements of the CMP by passage of legislation which was a companion to			
12	Proposition 111 and which is encoded in California Government Code Sections 65088			
13	and 65089.10; and			
14	WHEREAS, the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority			
15	(Metro) has been designated as the Congestion Management Agency responsible for			
16	administering Los Angeles County's CMP; and			
17	WHEREAS, California Government Code Section 65089.3 allows urbanized			
18	counties to be exempt from the CMP based on resolutions passed by local jurisdictions			
19	representing a majority of a county's jurisdictions with a majority of the county's			
20	population; and			
21	WHEREAS, the CMP is outdated and increasingly out of step with current			
22	regional, State, and federal planning processes and requirements, including new State			
23	requirements for transportation performance measures related to greenhouse gas			
24	reduction; and			
25	WHEREAS, on June 28, 2018 the Metro Board of Directors took action to			
26	direct Metro staff to work with local jurisdictions to prepare the necessary resolutions to			
27	exempt Los Angeles County from the Congestion Management Program;			
28	NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as			
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1	follows:			
2	Section 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.			
3	Section 2. That the City of Long Beach, located in Los Angeles County,			
4	hereby elects to be exempt from the Congestion Management Program as described in			
5	California Government Code Sections 65088 to 65089.10.			
6	Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adopti			
7	by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
