## RESOLUTION NO. RES-19-0060

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH GOVDEALS, INC., FOR SURPLUS AUCTION SERVICES WITH RELATED SOLUTIONS, ON THE SAME TERMS AND CONDITIONS AFFORDED TO SOURCEWELL FORMERLY KNOWN AS THE NATIONAL JOINT POWERS ALLIANCE

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach (the "City"), Section 1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City requires surplus auction services with related solutions; and

WHEREAS, Sourcewell, formerly known as the National Joint Powers Alliance, has a Contract with GovDeals, Inc. for surplus auction services with related solutions, Contract No. 041316-GDI ("Sourcewell Contract"); and

WHEREAS, the City's participation in the Sourcewell Contract will facilitate acquisition of the surplus auction services with related solutions as well as provide considerable cost benefits to the City; and

WHEREAS, if the City had to go to formal bid rather than participate in the Sourcewell Contract considerably more funds would be required;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

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;	Section 2.	The City Mar	nager of the City is hereby authorized to enter into
contract with GovDeals, Inc. for surplus auction services with related solutions of			
substantially the same type and kind purchased by Sourcewell, formerly known as the			
National Joint Powers Alliance, pursuant to the Sourcewell Contract except as modified			
by mutual agreement of the City and GovDeals, Inc., and the purchase by the City shall			
be on the same terms and conditions afforded to Sourcewell, formerly known as the			
National Joint Powers Alliance, in a total amount not to exceed Two Hundred Thousand			
Dollars (\$200,000), until the Sourcewell Contract expires on June 22, 2020, with the			
option to renew for as long as the Sourcewell Contract is in effect, at the discretion of the			
City Manager.			
Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption			
by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
