SUBJECT: Fund Transfer for North Pine Neighborhood Angled Parking

RECOMMENDATION

Increase appropriations in the Capital Projects Fund Group in the Public Works Department by \$55,000, offset by the First Council District one-time District Priority Funds transferred from the Citywide Activities Department to support the creation of angled parking along Locust Avenue between 9th St. and 12th St.

DISCUSSION/BACKGROUND

This Council recommendation requests a funding transfer for the Public Works Department to re-stripe Locust Avenue between 9th St. and 12th St. in the North Pine neighborhood to create angled parking. This effort will help calm traffic and provide additional parking in the neighborhood.

This matter was reviewed by Budget Manager Grace H. Yoon on May 23, 2019.

FISCAL IMPACT

This recommendation provides funds to the Public Works Department to support the creation of angled parking in the North Pine neighborhood. The total appropriation increase of \$55,000 in the Capital Projects Fund Group in the Public Works Department is offset by a transfer of First Council District one-time District Priority Funds from the General Fund Group in the Citywide Activities Department. Completing this work is anticipated to result in a minimal impact to staff hours beyond normal budgeted scope of duties and a minimal impact on Council priorities.

SUGGESTED ACTION

Approve recommendation.
