Goal: Decrease the number of STDs and HIV in Long Beach.

Focus Area: Youth

Objectives:

- 1. To increase STD/HIV awareness among youth, especially youth of color (Goal 3, Objective 1, 2)
- 2. Increase STD and HIV testing and treatment among high risk youth (Goal 1, Objective 1, 3)
 - Presented STD/HIV 101 at Cabrillo High School on April 2nd to 12 students
 - Presented Unhealthy and Healthy Relationships at Cabrillo High School on April 9th to 12 students
 - Presented Sex Ed at Lakewood High School on May 14th/15th to 180 students
 - Presented Sex Ed at McBride High School on May 21 to 260 students
 - Presented Unhealthy and Healthy Relationships at McBride High School on May 21st to 300 students

Focus Area: Providers

Objectives:

- 1. To ensure healthcare clinicians adequately diagnose, treat, and report STDs (Goal 1, Obj 1, 3; Goal 2, Obj 2)
- 2. To increase healthcare clinician situational awareness regarding STDs/HIV in Long Beach (Goal 2, Obj 2)
- 3. To increase awareness and prescribing or referral for PrEP (Goal 5, Objective 1, 2)
- Provided a syphilis educational lesson to 13 providers at Memorial Care on 5/6/19 at 12:00p.m.
- Provided a STD and HIV trends at St. Mary CARE Clinic on 5/8/19 at 8:30a.m.
- Provided a STD and HIV trends at the HIV Planning Meeting on 5/8/19 at 12:00 p.m.
- Tarzana- Provided syphilis education to MA on 4/8/19
- Community Medical Wellness Center- Informed clinic about the reporting laws and misdiagnosis of syphilis. Offered to provide education for their providers. Provided 5 provider folders to clinic on 4/12/19.
- Community Medical Wellness Center- Provided staff with a syphilis 101 class and provided condoms.

Focus Area: At Risk Populations (MSM, youth, pregnant women and people of color)

Objectives:

- 1. To increase STD/HIV awareness among high risk populations (Goal 1, Objective 1, 3)
- 2. To provide resources and decrease barriers to facilitate STD/HIV prevention (Goal 3, Objective 2)
- 3. To increase awareness and use of PrEP (Goal 5)
- Tabled at Beach Streets April 27th to hand out condoms, STD, HIV, and PrEP education to the community.
- Tabled at Long Beach Pride Celebration May 18th and 19th to hand out condoms, STD, HIV, and PrEP education to the community.

Focus Area: Our Partners

Objectives:

- 1. To collaborate with our partners to develop and implement a Long Beach STD/HIV Prevention and Control Plan
- 2. To collaborate with our partners to meet the above objectives
- Delivered overview of HIV/STD Strategy 2019-2022 to Long Beach Comprehensive HIV Planning Group 5/8/19
- Participated in press conference and media interviews with Mayor Garcia and community stakeholders 5/6/19

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Focus Area: Funding

Objectives:

1. Increase funding for STDs (Goal 2, Objective 1)

- Participated in STD Federal Action Plan Listening Session May 9, 2019, highlighting the need for increased funding for public health infrastructure.
- Participated in CSHCA/STDCB call to discuss funding methodologies for upcoming state funding 6/28/19
- Applying for \$717, 762 in funding to LAC RFP for STD Screening Diagnosis and Treatment Services over 3 years
- Applying for \$394, 174 for Social and Sexual Network HIV Testing over 3 years to LAC RFP
