DISCUSSION

On October 14, 2007 a Long Beach Police Officer drove her marked police car into the back of Plaintiffs' car while Plaintiffs were stopped at a traffic light. Plaintiffs sustained personal injuries and property damage.

Following settlement discussions with Plaintiffs' counsel, Plaintiffs have agreed to settle this matter for \$ 13,000.00. The proposed settlement was presented to the Economic Development and Finance Committee on October 6, 2009, and was approved on that date. We therefore ask authority to pay the sum of \$ 13,000 in full settlement of this lawsuit.
