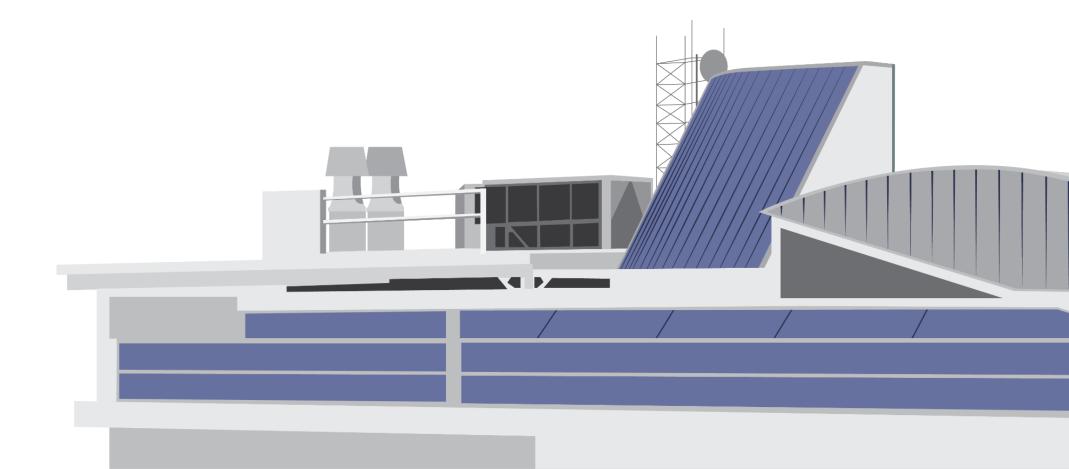

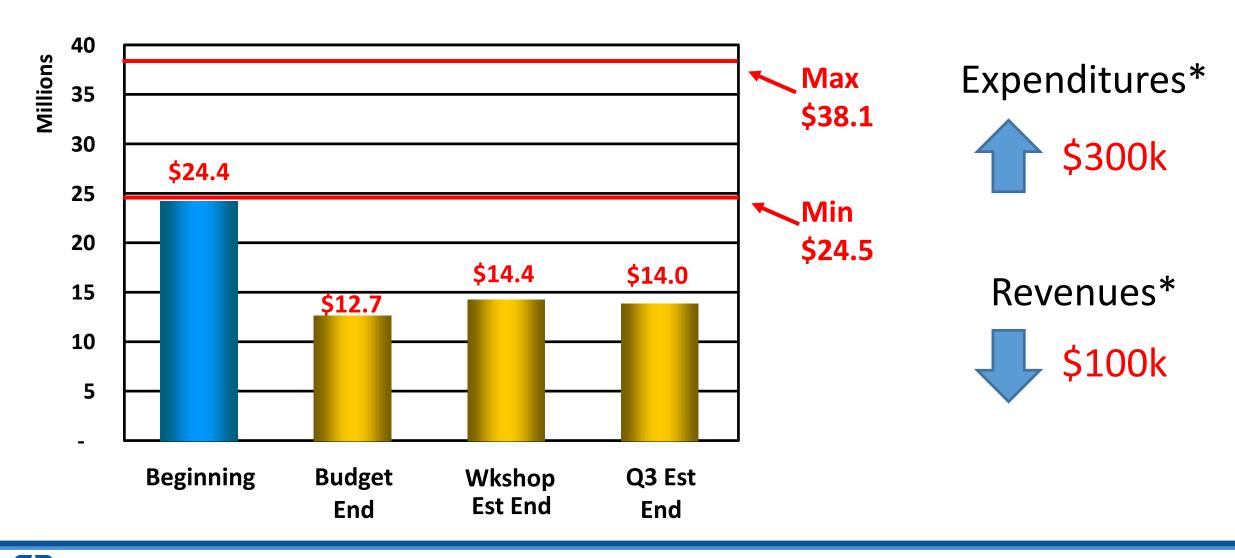


FY 19 Ending Water Fund Balance

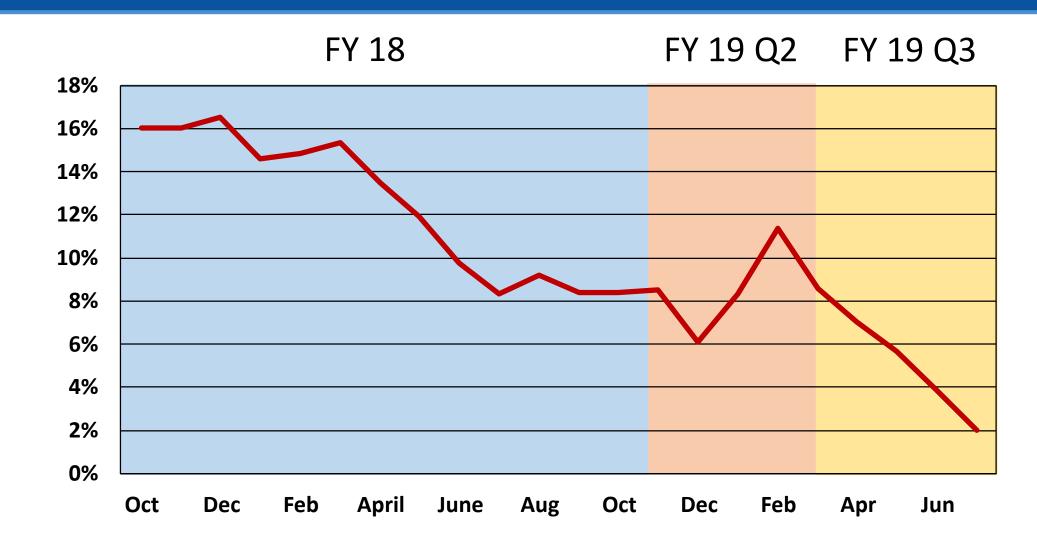

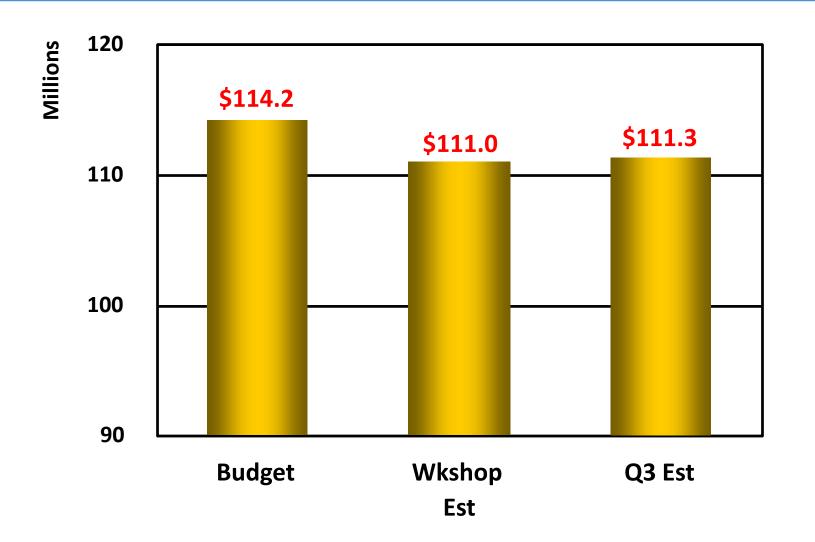


Water Fund Vacancy Rate FY 18 - Present



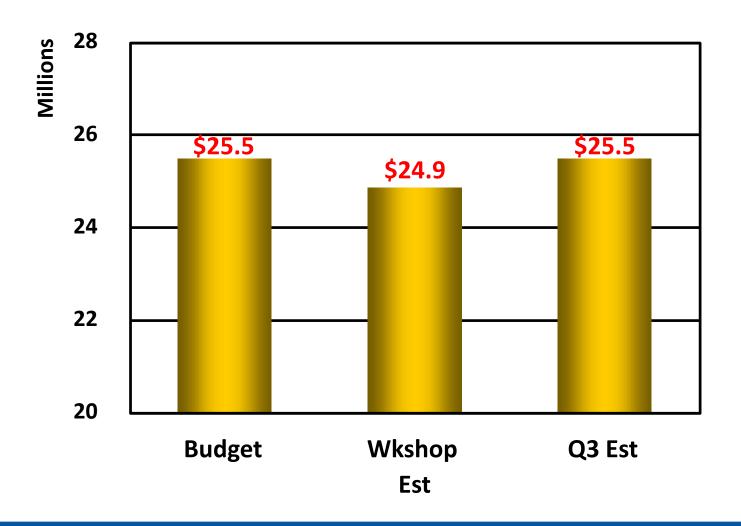


Water Fund Expenditures (Minus Seawater Barrier and AMI)





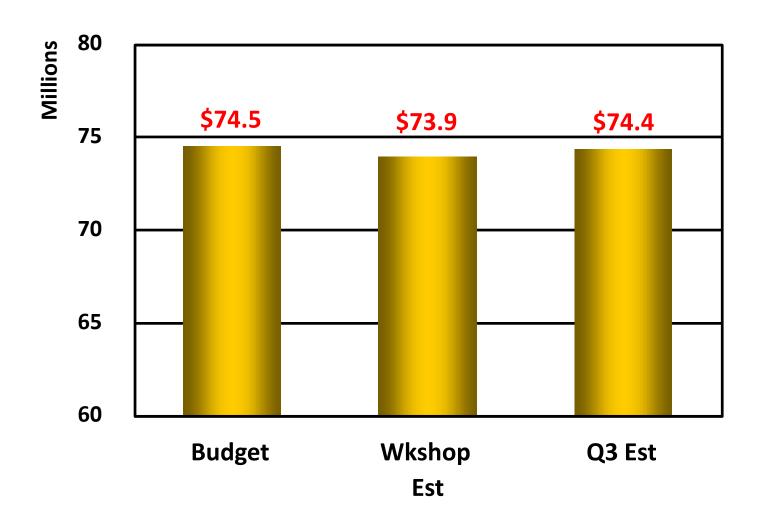
Water Fund Labor

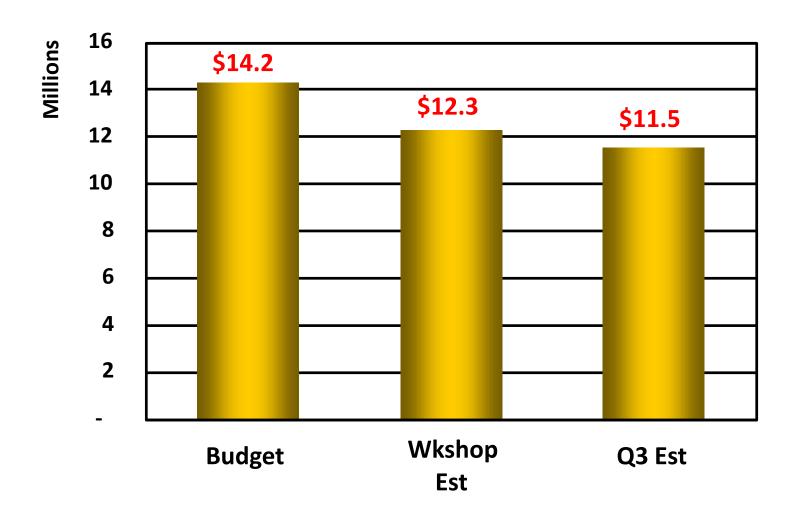

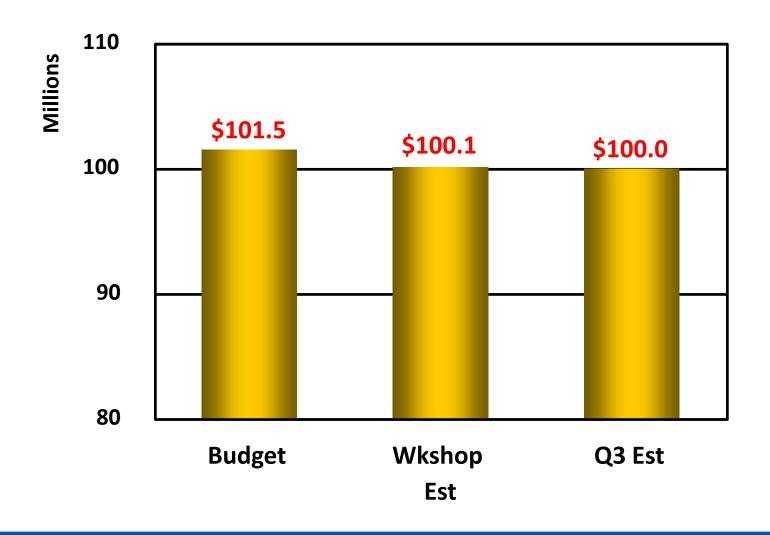

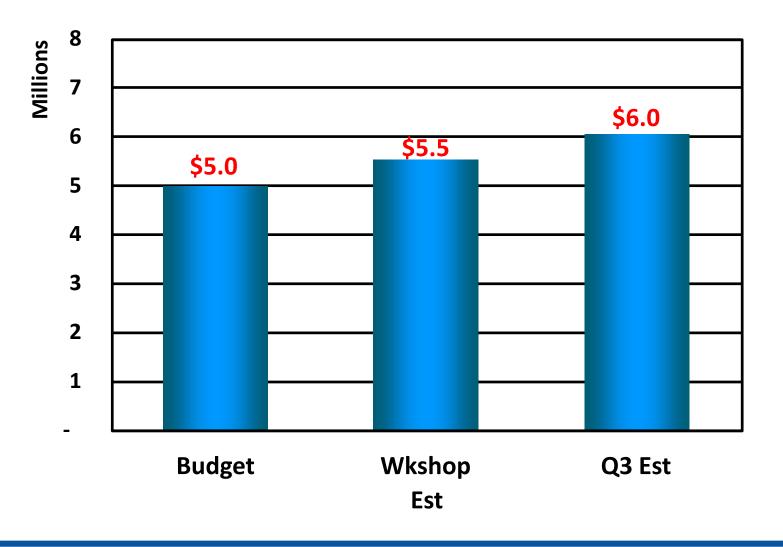
Sewer Fund Expenditures (Minus AMI Capital)





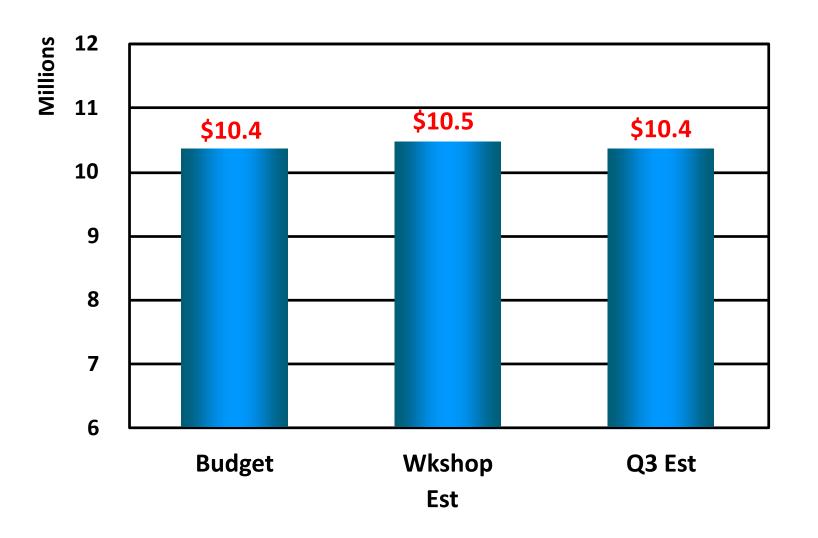

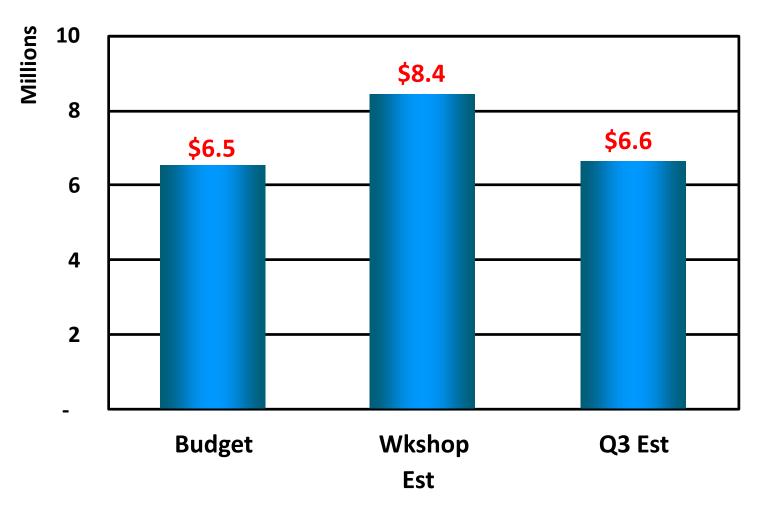

Sewer Fund Operations



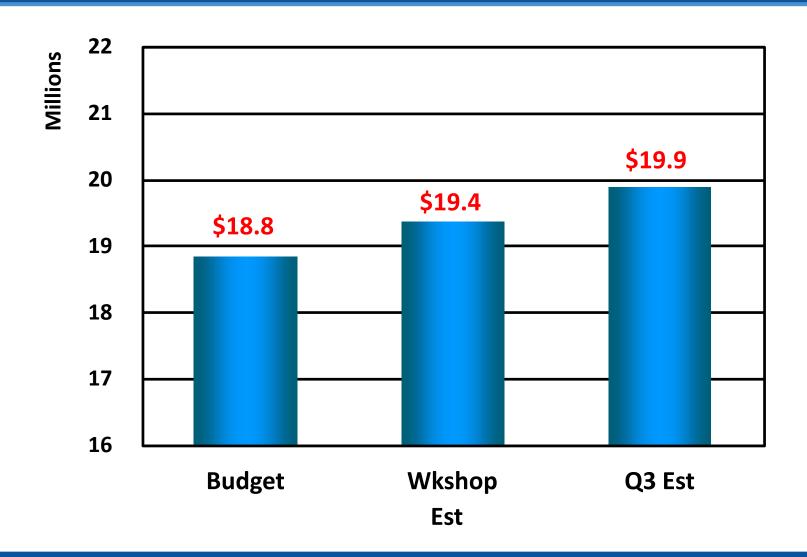
- Sanitary Sewer Management Plan \$75k (unbudgeted)
