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9	WHEREAS, the City Council meets on a weekly basis except for the			
10	last Tuesday of each month; and			
11	WHEREAS, one-third of the City Council meetings in 2018 lasted six			
12	and a half hours or longer, and concluded at 11:30 p.m. or later; and			
13	WHEREAS, discussion of important public business in the late hours			
14	of long City Council meetings can potentially diminish public participation; and			
15	WHEREAS, the City Council desires to adopt practices for			
16	streamlining the length of City Council meetings to foster public input and			
17	participation; and			
18	WHEREAS, the City Council believe this order of business will assist			
19	in efficient City Council meetings;			
20	NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach			
21	ordains as follows:			
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23	Section 1. Section 2.03.040 of the Long Beach Municipal Code is			
24	amended and restated in its entirety to read as follows:			
25	2.03.040 Order of business.			
26	A. Except as set forth in this Section, the order of business			
27	of the City Council at all regular meetings shall be as follows, unless			
28	otherwise waived by consent of the Council:

1. 1 Call to order by Mayor; 2 2. Roll call of the City Council by City Clerk; 3 3. Moment of silence: 4 4. Pledge of Allegiance; 5 Consent calendar: 5. 6 а. Approval of the minutes of previous 7 meeting(s). 8 b. The consent calendar shall be heard 9 immediately after the pledge of allegiance, and prior to 6:30 PM. 10 C. Any item removed from the consent calendar 11 for separate action shall be heard as the first item on the regular 12 agenda. 13 6. Ceremonials and Presentations. Ceremonials and 14 presentations shall: 15 a. Be limited to no more than three (3) 16 ceremonials and/or presentations per City Council meeting; and 17 b. Not exceed five (5) minutes per ceremonial 18 or presentation. 19 7. Hearings: 20 8. Public Comment. The opportunity for members of 21 the public to address the City Council on matters of public business 22 which are not listed on the agenda but are within the subject matter 23 jurisdiction of the City Council, which shall be conducted in 24 accordance with the following rules: 25 Each person desiring to address the City а. Council pursuant to this part of the order of business shall submit their 26 27 name and the subject matter in writing to the City Clerk prior to the 28 commencement of the Council meeting;

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OFFICE OF THE CITY ATTORNEY CHARLES PARKIN, City Attorney 411 West Ocean Boulevard, 9th Floor b. All addresses to the City Council under this part shall be limited to three (3) minutes;

c. The total number of speakers under this part shall be limited to the first ten (10) persons who have submitted their names in writing to the City Clerk;

d. The total amount of time to be devoted to addresses under this part shall not exceed thirty (30) minutes unless said limit on the total amount of time is waived by consent of the City Council.

9. Unfinished business;

10. Regular agenda;

11. Ordinance(s);

12. New business:

a. A supplemental agenda item submitted by a Councilmember shall require a separate "Statement of Urgency" explaining why the item is urgent and is required to be added after agenda is posted. If the City Council deems that a supplemental agenda item added onto the posted agenda is not urgent, the item shall be laid over to a future City Council meeting.

b. Announcements.

13. Public Comment:

a. The opportunity for those members of the public to address the City Council on nonagenda items who have not already addressed the City Council on nonagenda items at the same meeting.

14. Adjournment. In the event the City Council desires to adjourn to a certain hour on another day, a motion shall be made either prior to or as part of the regular motion to adjourn indicating the

hour and date to which the meeting is adjourned.

B. Without objection by the City Council, the Mayor, or other presiding officer, may use their discretion to call for any agenda item out of order for consideration and disposition, as needed, to ensure an efficient flow of the meeting.

C. Public Comment for Agenda Items.

1. Each person desiring to address the City Council on an agenda item shall submit their name in writing to the City Clerk prior to the time that the Mayor, or other presiding officer, calls for the agenda item to be taken up for consideration. At that time, the speakers list for said agenda item will be closed and speakers will be called to speak at a time deemed appropriate by the Mayor, or presiding officer.

2. Where less than ten (10) members of the public submit their name to the Clerk to speak on a particular agenda item, each member of the public shall have three (3) minutes to address the City Council. Any member of the public in need of a translator pursuant to the City's Language Access Policy or accommodation pursuant to the American Disabilities Act shall have six (6) minutes.

3. Where more than ten (10) members of the public submit their name to the Clerk to speak on a particular agenda item, each member of the public shall have ninety (90) seconds to address the City Council. Any member of the public in need of a translator pursuant to the City's Language Access Policy or accommodation pursuant to the American Disabilities Act shall have one-hundred eighty (180) seconds.

D. The rules of parliamentary practice contained in "Robert's Rules of Order" shall govern the Council where applicable and not

otherwise inconsistent with any provision of this Code or other applicable laws.

1. Limits of debate by the City Council. Unless waived by consent of the City Council, a member of the City Council may speak on any debatable motion for an unlimited number of times for up to five (5) minutes at a time. This Section shall not apply to the time available for a Councilmember to present an item to the City Council. This Section shall apply to the conduct of the City Councilmembers during hearings.

Section 2. Section 2.03.060 of the Long Beach Municipal Code is amended and restated in its entirety to read as follows:

2.03.060 Committees.

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A. All committees shall be established by resolution of the City Council. The Mayor shall appoint the members of all such committees and shall designate which member of each committee shall act as Chairman and Vice Chairman. The Mayor may act as an ex officio member of all committees of which the Mayor is not an official member.

B. Each such committee established by resolution of the
City Council shall hold a meeting upon the call of the Chairman
thereof, or, in case of his refusal or inability to act, upon the call of the
Mayor. All committee meetings shall be public meetings, except in
those instances where an executive session may properly be held
under the Brown Act or other applicable law.

C. An agenda shall be prepared containing the specific items of business to be transacted, along with a brief general description of each item to be heard at a committee meeting. Items of

1	business shall be placed on the agenda at the direction of the			
2	Chairman, Vice Chairman, or member of such committee.			
3	D. All City Council Committee meetings shall end by the			
4	time listed for the next Committee meeting, Closed Session, or City			
5	Council meeting, as reflected in the published agenda.

7	Section 3. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this			
8	ordinance by the City Council and cause it to be posted in three (3) conspicuous			
9	places in the City of Long Beach, and it shall take effect on the thirty-first (31st)			
10	day after it is approved by the Mayor.
