A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH IN SUPPORT OF THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES' AMICUS BRIEF IN SUPPORT OF THE PETITIONER CITY OF BOISE v. ROBERT MARTIN ON PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI IN THE SUPREME COURT OF THE UNITED STATES

WHEREAS, on August 22, 2019, the City of Boise filed a petition for writ of certiorari in the Supreme Court of the United States to review the judgement of the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit in Martin v City of Boise; and

WHEREAS, on September 24, 2019, the County of Los Angeles joined 32 other cities and counties and the California State Association of Counties in submitting an amicus brief in support of the City of Boise in petitioning the Supreme Court of the United States to grant certiorari; and

WHEREAS, the Ninth Circuit's holding in this case has resulted in confusion among municipalities as to what constitutes shelter that is "practically available" within the jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the Ninth Circuit's holding has placed an enormous burden on municipalities in deciphering how to balance protection of public health and criminal enforcement against potential civil liability; and

WHEREAS, the Ninth Circuit's holding ultimately limits cities and counties in their ability to solve their local homelessness problem without fear of potential civil liability due to 8th Amendment implications in this case;
