HONORABLE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL City of Long Beach California

**RECOMMENDATION:** 

Adopt a Resolution authorizing the City Manager, or designee, to execute a contract and any necessary amendments, with Measurement Control Systems, of Santa Ana, CA, to furnish and deliver gas meters and other services and parts, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$150,000, for a period of two years, with the option to renew for two additional one-year periods, at the discretion of the City Manager. (Citywide)

## **DISCUSSION**

City Council approval is requested to enter into a contract with Measurement Control Systems, for the purchasing of gas meters and other services and parts.

The Energy Resources Department (ER) has installed Elster American gas meters for many large commercial and industrial customers in the cities of Long Beach and Signal Hill. ER's staff is fully trained on the operation, maintenance, and repair of these types of gas meters, which have proven reliable and durable. The previous distributor for Elster American meters was Eclipse, Inc. Currently, Measurement Control Systems is the sole authorized distributor of these types of gas meters for the Long Beach. ER requests authorization to execute a contract with Measurement Control Systems to purchase meters, regulators, and miscellaneous parts used during business operations.

City Charter Section 1801 requires that contracts for City purchases be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder after a competitive bid process but allows for awards without a competitive bid process if accompanied by a Resolution adopted by the City Council.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Richard F. Anthony on September 12, 2019, Purchasing Agent Tara Yeats on September 18, 2019, and by Revenue Management Officer Geraldine Alejo on September 20, 2019.

# TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

City Council action to adopt a Resolution and award a contract concurrently is requested on October 8, 2019, to ensure the contract is in place expeditiously.

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## FISCAL IMPACT

The total contract amount will not exceed \$150,000 and is budgeted in the Gas Fund Group in the Energy Resources Department. This recommendation has no staffing impact beyond the normal budgeted scope of duties and is consistent with existing City Council priorities. There is no local job impact associated with this recommendation.

## SUGGESTED ACTION

Approve recommendation.

13	WHEREAS, the Energy Resources Department ("Energy Resources")			
14	requires gas meters and other services and parts; and			
15	WHEREAS, Honeywell Manufacturers ("Honeywell") are the approved meter			
16	manufacturers for Energy Resources per the approved internal Guidelines, that has beer			
17	reviewed and vetted by the Engineering Bureau; and			
18	WHEREAS, Honeywell meters are specific to the City's natural gas pipeline			
19	distribution system, working with approved materials to meet DOT and PHSMA compliance			
20	regulations; and			
21	WHEREAS, Honeywell has changed their sole authorized distributor for our			
22	municipality from Eclipse, Inc. to Measurement Control Systems; and			
23	WHEREAS, no useful purpose would be served by advertising for bids for			
24	Honeywell gas meters and parts and to do so would constitute an idle and useless act and			
25	an unnecessary expenditure of public funds;			
26	NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves a			
27	follows:			
28	Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter a contract,

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OFFICE OF THE CITY ATTORNEY CHARLES PARKIN, City Attorney 411 West Ocean Boulevard, 9th Floor Lona Beach CA 90802 without advertising for bids, with Measurement Control Systems for the purchase of gas
meters and other services and parts as may be required by the City for a period of two (2)
years in an annual amount not to exceed One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000).
The parties may, by mutual agreement, extend the term for two (2) additional one-year
periods. If the sole source status of Measurement Control Systems changes, City shall
publicly bid instead of extending the contract.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
