I. Regulatory Background

ORDER No. 2006-003-DWQ

Key Requirements

- 1. Agencies must enroll for coverage under the SSS WDR
- 2. Reporting of all Sanitary Sewer Overflows (SSOs) to SWRCB's online database
- 3. System must have adequate capacity to convey peak flows
- 4. Develop and implement a Sewer System Management Plan (SSMP)
 - Update every 5 years

Every SSMP must include the following 11 elements:

- 1. Goal
- 2. Organization
- 3. Legal Authority
- 4. Operation and Maintenance Program
- 5. Design and Performance Provisions



- 6. Overflow Emergency Response Plan
- 7. Fats, Oils, and Grease (FOG) Control Program
- 8. System Evaluation and Capacity Assurance Plan
- 9. Monitoring, Measurement, and Program Modifications
- 10. SSMP Program Audits
- 11. Communication Program
