A RESOLUTION ORDERING THE VACATION OF SUBTERRANEAN AND AERIAL PORTIONS OF THE PROMENADE, BROADWAY AND ALTA WAY ADJACENT TO 200 E. BROADWAY, IN THE CITY OF LONG BEACH, COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, STATE OF CALIFORNIA
WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Long Beach, did heretofore, on the 7th day of, March , 200_6, by Resolution No. RES-06-0019, declare its intention to order the vacation, pursuant to the provisions of the Public Streets, Highways, and Service Easements Law, subterranean and aerial portions of The Promenade, Broadway and Alta Way adjacent to 200 E. Broadway in the City of Long Beach, County of Los Angeles, State of California, described more particularly as follows:

## Subterranean Portion of The Promenade

A strip of land in the City of Long Beach, County of Los Angeles, State of California, being the easterly 22.00 feet of The Promenade North, 80.00 feet wide, formerly Locust Avenue, as per map of "Townsite of Long Beach" recorded in Book 19, Pages 91 through 96, inclusive of Miscellaneous Records of said County, said strip bounded on the north by the westerly prolongation of the northerly line of Lot 2 of Block 103 of said map and bounded on the south by the westerly prolongation of the southerly line of Lot 16 of said Block 103, and bounded by an upper elevation of 28.58 feet at the northeasterly and southeasterly corner of said strip and bounded by an upper elevation of 28.14 feet at the northwesterly and southwesterly corner of said strip. Said strip has no lower limit.
Said elevations being based on City of Long Beach Benchmark No. 1386, located at the northeast corner of The Promenade North and Broadway. Lead and Tack in east end of catch basin, 75 feet east of the centerline of Promenade North, Elevation 29.503 feet, Datum 1929 NGVD 1985 CLB Adjustment.
Aerial Portions of The Promenade, Broadway and Alta Way
A strip of land in the City of Long Beach, County of Los Angeles, State of California, being the easterly 4.00 feet of The Promenade North, 80.00 feet wide, formerly Locust Avenue, as per map of "Townsite of Long Beach" recorded in Book 19, Pages 91 through 96, inclusive of Miscellaneous Records of said County, together with the southerly 3.00 feet of Broadway,

> 80.00 feet wide, per said map, and the northerly 3.00 feet of Alta Way, 10.00 feet wide, per said map, said strip bounded on the north by a line which is parallel with and northerly 3.00 feet from the northerly line of Lot 2 of Block 103 of said map and its westerly prolongation, bounded on the south by a line which is parallel with and southerly 3.00 feet from the southerly line of Lot 16 of Block 103 of said map and it's westerly prolongation, bounded on the east by a line which is parallel with and westerly 9.00 feet from the easterly line of Lot 2 of Block 103 of said map and it's northerly and southerly prolongations, and bounded on the west by a line which is parallel with and westerly 4.00 feet from the westerly line of Lot 2 of Block 103 of said map and it's northerly and southerly prolongations, and bounded by a lower elevation of 42.83 feet and bounded by an upper elevation of 89.33 feet.
> Said elevations being based on City of Long Beach Benchmark No. 1386 , located at the northeast corner of The Promenade North and Broadway. Lead and Tack in east end of catch basin, 75 feet east of the centerline of The Promenade North, Elevation 29.503 feet, Datum 1929 NGVD 1985 CLB Adjustment.

WHEREAS, the City Council did, at said time, fix Tuesday, the 4th day of April , 200 6, at the hour of 5:00 p.m., as the time at the City Council Chamber, Plaza Level of the City Hall, 333 West Ocean Boulevard, in the City of Long Beach, California, as the place for hearing for all persons interested in or objecting to the proposed vacation to appear and be heard; and

WHEREAS, notice of the resolution of the intention to vacate, stating the time and place of said hearing, were duly posted in the manner prescribed by law; and

WHEREAS, said hearing was called and held before the City Council at the time and place so fixed and evidence taken and received on the matter of said proposed vacation, and the City Council, upon said evidence, now make those findings of fact set forth in said Exhibit " $B$ ", attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to the foregoing resolution of intention, the proceedings had thereunder, the "SKETCH SHOWING VACATION OF THE SUBTERRANEAN PORTION OF THE PROMENADE AND AERIAL PORTIONS OF THE PROMENADE, BROADWAY AND ALTA WAY TO BE VACATED BY THE CITY OF LONG BEACH" attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and the City Council Findings attached hereto as Exhibit
" B ", said City Council of the City of Long Beach hereby makes its resolution vacating and closing a portion of the drive hereinabove described.

Sec. 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk is hereby instructed to certify to the adoption thereof, and to cause a certified copy to be recorded in the Office of the County Recorder of the County of Los Angeles, California.

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## CITY COUNCIL FINDINGS

1. The subject right-of-way is unnecessary for present or prospective public use.

This finding is based upon the following subfindings:
a) Those findings stated in the City Manager's letter submitted for the March 7, 2006 City Council meeting regarding the resolution of intention to vacate the subject right-of-way, adopted as RES-06-0019.
b) The rights-of-way would not be useful for exclusive bikeway purposes.
2. The vacation of said rights-of-way will not have a significantly adverse environmental effect.

a) The right-of-way is not and will not be needed for public use.
b) In conformance with the California Environmental Quality Act, Negative Declaration Number ND 30-04 was certified for this project.
