1) Parking here is already very limited, especially with the street sweeping scheduled very early in the a.m. hours for half of this street on Friday. If this venue has live entertainment/bar activity at night, the residents will not have parking when they get home from work.

2) Live music plus alcohol/marijuana always means it is going to be loud and people will be partying out by their cars. This will be a haven for illegal activity and just plain noisy in what should be a quiet neighborhood setting.
