City Council Letters

- (4/14) Recommendation to authorize City Manager, or designee, to execute all necessary documents to amend the U.S. Economic Development Administration (EDA) Revolving Loan Fund, to create the Long Beach Emergency Microenterprise Loan Program to assist local micro businesses impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic during the emergency declaration period.
