



Business Hotline and Call Center

- On March 21st, City staff officially launched the Business Hotline and Call Center.
- City staff partnered with the Parks, Recreation and Marine Department to train part-time City staff to respond to COVID-19 business and worker-related questions.
- Hired a total of seventeen Call Center staff.
- Collectively, the Call Center staff has responded to over 1,200 calls from business owners and workers.

KIVA LONG BEACH LOAN PROGRAM

The Kiva Long Beach Loan Program is an online community-lending program that supports Long Beach small businesses.

Loan amounts range from **\$500 to \$15,000** **0%** Interest rate

Repayment period ranges from **6 months to 3 years**
*Borrowers may access a grace period of up to 6 months

- Loan proceeds may be used for business expenses such as personnel, rent, supplies/materials, utilities, professional services and more.
- All loan applications are reviewed and either approved or denied by Kiva (the non-profit entity).
- Loans that are approved by the Kiva entity have 30 days to successfully raise the entire loan amount. The total loan amount must be raised for funds to be made available to the borrower.

CITY OF LONG BEACH ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT BUSINESS FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PAYCHECK PROTECTION PROGRAM

PAYCHECK PROTECTION PROGRAM

The Payment Protection Program supports businesses by keeping their work force employed during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Up to **\$10 million** available **1% interest rate over two years**

The first payment is deferred for six months

- Loan proceeds may be used for payroll, rent, mortgage interest or utilities prior to February 15, 2020 and after.
- Loan amounts will be determined by 2.5 times average monthly payroll costs capped at \$100,000 per employee.
- There are no collateral requirements, no personal guarantees or credit score minimums.
- There are no fees payable to the lender or the Small Business Administration (SBA).
- Potential borrowers can apply through any existing SBA 7(a) lender, any participating federally insured depository institution, or federal credit union.
- Up to 100% forgiveness of the loan amount equal to the sum of the qualified costs incurred and payments made during the covered 8-week period following loan origination.
- At least 75% of the loan must be used for payroll costs.
- The Paycheck Protection Program will be available through June 30, 2020.

ECONOMIC INJURY DISASTER LOAN PROGRAM

The Economic Injury Disaster Loan Program supports businesses and non-profits with 500 employees or fewer and provides vital economic support to small businesses to help overcome the temporary loss of revenue they are experiencing as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Up to available loans of **\$2 million** **3.75%** Interest rate for businesses **2.75%** Interest rate for non-profits

Repayment period is up to **30 years**
*Borrowers may access a grace period of up to 9 months

- Loan proceeds may be used for business expenses such as rent, payroll, accounts payable and other operating expenses.
- Funding is subject to availability and submittal of a loan application does not guarantee funding.
- Businesses are also eligible to apply for Economic Injury Disaster Loan advance of up to \$10,000. The loan advance will provide economic relief to businesses that are experiencing a temporary loss of revenue. Funds will be made available within three days of successful application, and this loan advance will not have to be repaid.

CITY OF LONG BEACH ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT BUSINESS FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE LONG BEACH MICROLOAN PROGRAM

EMERGENCY MICROLOAN PROGRAM

The Emergency Microloan Program supports Long Beach businesses and non-profits with five or fewer employees that have been financially burdened during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Loan amounts range from **\$2,500 to \$10,000** **2.44%** Interest rate

Repayment period ranges from **5 to 7 years**
*borrowers may access a grace period of up to 9 months

- Loan proceeds may be used for business expenses such as personnel, rent, supplies/materials, utilities, professional services and more.
- Funding is subject to availability and submittal of a loan application does not guarantee funding.




