## THIRD AMENDMENT TO PRODUCED WATER AGREEMENT (NO. 32869)

## 

This Third Amendment to Produced Water Agreement (No. 32869) is made and entered, in triplicate, as of March 17, 2020, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting held on March 17, 2020, by and among:

CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation, acting in its capacity as Unit Operator for Unit Segments I and II, under the Unit Agreements, Fault Blocks II, III, IV and V Ranger Zone Units and as operator of certain Ununitized formations in the Wilmington Oil Field, hereinafter collectively referred to as "City";

**TIDELANDS OIL PRODUCTION COMPANY**, a Texas general partnership, hereinafter referred to as "Tidelands";

**AND** 

OIL OPERATORS, INC., a California corporation, hereinafter referred to as "Oil Operators";

## **RECITALS**

This Third Amendment to Produced Water Agreement ("Amendment") is made and entered into with respect to the following facts and objectives:

- (A) The parties hereto entered into that certain Produced Water Agreement, effective September 24, 2001 (as the same has previously been amended, the "Agreement"), pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting held on August 28, 2001, and have each duly performed pursuant to the terms thereof.
- (B) The parties entered into that certain First Amendment to Agreement for the Delivery of Produced Water From Oil Operators, dated August 25, 2006, which, among other things, extended the term of the Agreement.
  - (C) The parties entered into that certain Second Amendment to

Agreement Produced Water Agreement, dated July 26, 2012, which, among other things, extended the term of the Agreement.

Oil Operators plans to make significant capital improvements to its (D) pipelines and desires to secure the Agreement for an extended term of six (6) years from the current expiration date of the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties mutually agree as follows:

- Section 1 of the Agreement is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:
- "1. TERM. This Agreement shall continue to be effective, and remain in effect until August 25, 2026. This Agreement shall thereafter automatically be renewed for successive one (1) year terms unless any party shall deliver to the other parties written notice of an election to terminate this Agreement not later than thirty (30) days prior to the then-scheduled expiration of the term of this Agreement. All such renewals shall be on the same terms and conditions as contained in this Agreement."
- 2. CONTRACT PRICE. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Agreement, Oil Operators shall only be obligated to pay Tidelands for the first 17,000 barrels of Oil Operators Produced Water per day at a rate equal to \$0.027 per barrel. Oil Operators shall have no obligation to pay for additional daily deliveries of Oil Operators Produced Water in excess of 17,000 barrels, and the per barrel price shall no longer be adjusted in accordance with CPI.
- Except as specifically amended by this Amendment, all terms and 3. conditions of the Agreement are ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.
