



I will provide a positive team contribution with the Independent Redistricting Commission because of my past involvement with various City Commissions and Committees that represented target areas along different council districts such as:

Long Beach Blvd./Light Rail Transit Corridor Design Ad Hoc Committee - 1989-1990 approx. The committee considered selection of closures of east-west streets along the corridor to accommodate traffic demands and considerations to mitigate adverse impacts on present and future businesses along the corridor from Willow south to Anaheim.

#### Community Development Advisory Commission - 1990-1998.

The members advised City staff on identification of targeted residential and business areas eligible to counter blighting conditions with infusions of City, State and HUD funds. For most of the eight years served, I was the only Hispanic member although the Hispanic population was about 27 per cent. This pattern remained with my service on other committees.

Atlantic Avenue-Long Beach Blvd. Redevelopment Advisory Committee - 1990-1994. I served the initial three years as Vice-Chair and Parliamentarian; the fourth year I served as agenda Co-Chair. In an effort to comply with State Redevelopment agency laws, I coined the phrases "Sphere of Influence" and "Certificates of Conformity" to mean in the concept of Redevelopment Committee membership, that a legal nexus to include residents and businesses that were beyond the legal boundaries required, to be included due to the arguably direct effects of proposed new land-use regulations with the former. With the "Certificate of Conformity", the use of this term used elsewhere in land use regulations, would mean that if particular residence met certain housing functional and cosmetic standards, that these properties would be exempt from the use of government use of *eminent domain* and that these residents could continue to live in their desired homes. The State approved both definitions and scope of these two concepts.

Business-Friendy Planning and Building Departments Ad Hoc Committee - 1999 approx. I served with different businesses owners to reduce the negative impacts that was claimed to impede the issuance of building permits by reclassifying the permitted scope and costs in obtaining a permit.

#### Neighborhood Preservation Loan Committee - 1996-1998.

I served the three years of the Committee as Vice-Chair. This advisory committee reviewed residential improvement loan applications for specific properties in targeted areas in different council districts while maintaining affordability for its tenants.

#### Owners and Managers Housing Authority Committee -1997-1998 approx.

I was the first member, unanimously elected by fellow owner and managers. The committee was created to lessen the acrimonious environment between the Housing Authority staff and owners by standardizing the inspection process regardless of the type of residential unit provided and to ease implementation of other regulatory aspects of federal, State and local implementation regarding subsidized housing.

### PERTINENT EMPRICAL OBSEVATIONS ON FEDERAL AND STATE 'VOTING RIGHTS ACT'

The following is provided to demonstrate that I have maintained an interest on the geographic effect on voting rights for many years and for consideration of Commission membership:

I grew up in an area of Torrance, California which became incorporated into the City of Carson as did parts of the cities of Gardena, Compton and Wilmington. I saw first-hand the effects of 'at-large' voting, in the absence of neighborhood and business identification in a multicultural social-economic-political subjecting neighborhood clusters to disparity.

I moved to Long Beach in 1976. When the various City council district elections were being held, I noticed that the 6<sup>TH</sup> District was drawn with a long thin finger-like protrusion going west for about a mile. I could find no one to explain this anomaly and so I tried to find a nexus with my empirical knowledge of the area and concluded that this was a classic textbook example of Gerrymandering. I could not identify the beneficiaries until several years later, where it surprisingly did not benefit a group but instead politically ambitious individuals. The boundary shifts with the other Council Districts seemed to follow the traditional one man one vote equal population categories with the exception of the 7<sup>th</sup> District which was forced to exchange land/neighborhood boundaries with the 6th district.

During later council elections, I spoke before the City Council and addressed my concerns for a return to the previous geographic boundaries which had existed for many decades or to a less divergent scheme to reflect homogeneous neighborhoods now separated by shifting imaginary lines with questionable justification.

Another instance of council geographic realignment occurred during late 1990<sup>,8</sup> where the landmark Norm's restaurant and other nearby businesses (Pacific Coast Highway and Long Beach Blvd.) were given up at the urging of the Council representative in exchange for a cluster of four homes located near St. Mary's Hospital. These residents claimed that their voting rights in their council district were rendered meaningless because they represented a very small racial minority within the council district.

I believe that the families that voluntarily moved into this cluster of homes knew the special district attributes beforehand, similar to the old legal maxim of "coming to the nuisance". The courts opined under different circumstances that those knowingly moving into an area of claimed nuisance could not complain because of their prior knowledge of environmental attributes of existing land users. Secondly, these families could also envision that a minority person could run for office in this district anytime in the future.

My concern was that voting district configurations that lacked rationality were in violation of the federal and State Voting Rights Act, disenfranchised neighbors and neighborhoods much with

the same consequences of the negative aspects of "at-large" voting systems.

I have studied other municipal jurisdictions with information available regarding different aspects of the Voting Rights Act.

### PROPOSED RE-DISTRICTING CITY EFFORTS

The City of Long Beach is currently experiencing a dramatic increase in high density residential construction along its commercial corridors throughout the City under new State affordable housing laws. The impact of this societal change of land-use due to businesses that catered to a past economy that languished for many years created a visible blight along these major corridors and provided few services to desirable low density neighborhoods to the interior of these corridors or to other businesses lacking mutual attractions of a customer base.

This dramatic increase in population will alter concepts of neighborhood, public school attendance, shopping district traffic, changes of council district boundaries under the one person one vote concept, and other infrastructure challenges.

I believe that I can be an impartial team member ensuring the integrity and rationality of the re-districting effort that the City of Long Beach will undertake.

#### THE HONEY-BEE EFFECT

For many years the nature of my real estate/construction businesses required that I transact my business interests with site specific business locations throughout the City. Their main source of pertinent local information was dependent on their customers and clients. Because I served on several City volunteer agencies, I tried to provide information gained at these meetings along with information gathered from other business owners – my efforts being described by some as a bee going from flower-to-flower. If selected, I would anticipate providing a broadly based perspective to this team effort to compliment the benefits of those providing a more specific contribution.
