Representative democracy works best when representatives are responsive to the communities they represent. When communities are artificially split up into different districts or when political lines no longer reflect the realities that residents face, we run the risk that government is no longer representative.

I have long been committed to local governance. Twenty years ago, when I was in college, I was a Transportation Commissioner for the City of Berkeley, CA. Ten years later, when I was in law school and graduate school, I was actively involved in the Participatory Budgeting process in my city council district in Brooklyn, NY.

For the past 8 years, I have lived here in Long Beach. I rented an apartment in the 2nd District, near Bixby Park, and I now own a home in the 4th District, near the traffic circle. I was an adjunct professor at Cal State Long Beach while finishing my PhD.

One of the things I love most about Long Beach is the strength of its communities. For the past 8 years I have organized a monthly beach clean-up at Cherry Beach. Through this clean-up I have worked with volunteers from all over the city and county, local businesses, schools, Parks & Recreation, local political leaders, and non-profits such as Surfrider Foundation. As a board member of the Friends of Bixby Park, I worked with the city council and city departments on improving the park.

I have spent years studying the law, government, and public policy. I have a J.D., Masters of Public Administration, and a PhD in Criminology, Law & Society. I have extensively studied advanced statistical techniques and taught statistics courses.
