It was a point where the programs were completely cut and the crime rate rose along with drug activity. Sadly around that time I was associated with the wrong crowd, but my father did not want me to be a product of my environment so he sent me off to school because he knew my potentially. While in college stepped away from my environment, and went to a great HBCU in Missouri where I grew wings of confidence. While in School I served as a representative for my organization (Colored Women's Club)in the Student Government Association. I had the experience of writing speech in as well as asking for funds for specific activities. Then fast forward to me graduating, I then moved to the Bay Are where I did alot of community work feeding the homeless while even not having a home of my own, and yes I was a homeless single mother at one point. That point of homelessness helped me to see the bigger need in our cities, being at the lowest of the low. As far as work History i have worked on Skid Row as a Case Manager for the Downtown Women's center and SRO. When coming into full recovery from different experiences I have had it has taught me that this has all built up to me being an agent for change. Long Beach is thriving but what I dont want to witness is Gentrification especially without the youth having the opportunity to get into free programs that would align them with a great future.

Right now I work as a qualified Intellectual Disability Professional and of course I play a key role in supervising staff creating and facilitating activities, and pretty much running all programming, which concludes that yes I may not have years of experience working in this sector however with the broad experience that I have I know the needs, I know Long Beach, and I have gained analytical thinking just through surviving and being in the position I'm in now. I love working with others as a team to coordinate and make things happen. Hope this serves to whom it may concern well.
