I have always loved architecture and have a keen interest in sociology and how people live and work within a city and survive. I'm sure plenty of people will apply to be on this commission, and I would hope that many of them are qualified candidates. So why should you pick me? I have high energy, I'm willing to work, and I play well with others. I've worked with students in the LBUSD for 25 years and I think I have a perspective that many don't have unless you work in the field of education. I see and hear firsthand the struggles that the children in our communities go through. Some neighborhoods have more than others and well to some this may be OK, if we're going to change the boundary lines we need to make sure that all neighborhoods have what the other neighborhoods have.
