City Light & Power, Inc. (CLP) is pleased to submit a proposal to install light emitting diode (LED) lamps to the existing shoebox fixtures located in the city-owned Belmont Shore parking lot lights to LED. Below is a description of work:

CLP will furnish labor, material and equipment to remove (24) 250W HPS lamp, bypass the existing fixtures components and install a 54W LED lamp. Once converted, CLP will energize the circuits to ensure the fixtures are working properly.

The cost to complete this project: **Seven Thousand Four Hundred Five Dollars (\$7,405).**

Notes/Assumptions:

- Locations: 184 Santa Ana Ave., 179 Pomona Ave., 185 Covina Ave., 185 Nieto Ave., 181 Granada Ave. No City owned lights in Park Ave. lot.
- Pricing based on operational lights and does not include replacement of additional components (wire, fuses etc.). If required, additional repairs will be invoiced on a T&M basis.
- Pricing based on 100-277V
- Recommend the City request that SCE convert SCE owned fixtures to LED for additional lighting.
