**Belmont Shore Parking and Business Improvement Area Commission Members**

**SUBJECT:** Recommendation to approve expenditure to purchase a multi-space meter, replace signage, restripe parking stalls, and install a concrete footing in the parking lot bordered by Second St. to the south, Livingston Dr. to the north, Park Ave. to the east, and Quincy Ave. to the west at a cost not to exceed \$11,000.

**DISCUSSION**

City staff recommends removing and replacing the coin-only parking meters located in the parking lot bordered by Second St. to the south, Livingston Dr. to the north, Park Ave. to the east, and Quincy Ave. to the west, with a T2 Luke II multi-space meter, an updated version of the multi-space meter currently located in the Park Ave lot. The vendor is offering the T2 Luke II multi-space meter at a discount rate of 54%. Installation of the new meter will provide more payment options, allow for easy holiday payment programming changes, and connect to the City's Smarking data analytics platform providing data on usage and payment type.

The Public Works Traffic Operations team will complete the meter installation, encompassing removal of existing meters, concrete footing, meter installation, surface restoration, parking stall restriping, stall numbering, and sign installation.

The total project cost is not to exceed \$11,000, funded by the remaining Community Facilities District No. 2007-2 (Belmont Shore) bond proceeds as an authorized parking improvement.
