<p><b>Multiple Training Hearings</b> January - March 2021</p>	<p>Commissioner Trainings and presentations from redistricting experts, former redistricting commissioners.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Rules of the Road (general redistricting overview)</li> <li>- Redistricting Law and Federal Voting Rights Act</li> <li>- Role of the Commissioner</li> <li>- Communities of Interest</li> <li>- City of Long Beach Demographics/Analysis</li> </ul>
<p><b>Outreach Hearings</b> Several city-wide commission hearings 9 “in-district” hearings March 2021 – June 2021</p>	<p>Series of public outreach hearings. Each will begin with information about the redistricting process, the role of the commission, descriptions of the data and mapping tools, introduction of ways the community can provide input, including the online mapping tools.</p> <p>The purpose of these hearings is to provide information to the public and solicit input on where community of interests exist, what connects them, how they interact with the city and how those can contribute to the building of potential districts.</p>
<p><b>Post-US Census Release Commission Hearing</b>  TBD</p>	<p>Presentation of new census data, impacts on citywide population and population deviations / ethnic composition of existing districts, information on ideal district size, voting rights act considerations in light of final data release.</p>
<p><b>Post Mapping Outreach Hearings</b>  TBD</p>	<p>Presentation of maps of new potential district boundaries produced by the demographer and <i>published seven days in advance</i>, with a summary of how mapping options were drawn from testimony and public input received during the previous hearings. These maps are expected to drive additional feedback from the public.</p>
<p><b>Plan Adoption Hearing</b> By December 7, 2021</p>	<p>Public Hearing to adopt final redistricting plan.</p>
